BBSSL Scheme Brings New Hope for Hry

New Delhi: The Home Minister Shri Amit Shah, who is also the Minister of Cooperation informed the Lok Sabha regarding the Bhartiya Beej Sahakari Samiti Limited (BBSSL). This disclosure came in response to an unstarred question posed in the Lok Sabha by Shri Satpal Brahamchari regarding the extent to which farmers in Haryana are benefiting from the BBSSL scheme.
Data on Farmer Participation

According to the Ministry, BBSSL, established under the Multi-State Cooperative Societies (MSCS) Act, 2002, has seen substantial participation from Haryana. Promoted by major cooperative organizations like IFFCO, KRIBHCO, NAFED, the National Dairy Development Board (NDDB), and the National Cooperative Development Corporation (NCDC), BBSSL began with an initial paid-up capital of ₹250 crore. Each of the five promoters contributed ₹50 crore, with the authorized share capital set at ₹500 crore. As of now, BBSSL has received 683 ap-As of flow, BBSL has received oss applications from Haryana, out of which 32 applicant societies are from Sonipat. Out of these, 26 cooperatives have been granted membership. On July 23, 2024, BBSL obtained a seed license from the Government of Haryana, enabling it to start operations through its network of member cooperatives in the state. Activities and Objectives

The BBSSL scheme is designed to revolutionize seed production and distribution in India. Through its network of cooperatives, BBSSL will focus on producing, procuring, and distributing quality seeds



under a single brand. The scheme aims to improve crop yield and establish a system for preserving and promoting indigenous natural seeds.

Impact on Rural Economy
The implementation of the BBSSL scheme is expected to significantly boost the rural economy and seed production. By increasing the production of quality seeds through cooperatives, the scheme aims to reduce India's dependence on imported seeds and enhance overall agricultural productivity. This initiative aligns with the broader goals of the "Make in India" campaign and the vision of Atmanirbhar Bharat (Self-Reliant India).

Moreover, BBSSL's activities are expected to promote inclusive growth through the cooperative model, under the slogan "Sahakar-se-Samriddhi" (Prosperity through Cooperation). Farmers stand to benefit from better prices for high-quality seeds, increased crop production through the use of High Yielding Variety (HYV) seeds, and dividends distributed from the surplus generated by the society.

Wayanad landslides: PM Modi speaks to Kerala CM and assures help from Centre, announces ex-gratia

New Delhi: Prime Minister Narendra Modi spoke with Kerala Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan today (July 30) and assured him of all possible assistance from the Centre following the landslides in Wayanad district, which resulted in the deaths of eleven people, including children.

"Distressed by the landslides in parts of Wayanad. My thoughts are with all those who have lost their loved ones and prayers with those injured. Rescue ops are currently underway to assist all those affected. Spoke to Kerala CM Shri @pinarayivijayan and also assured all possible help from the Centre in the wake of the prevailing situation there," PM Modi wrote in a post on X.

Official sources said that Prime Minister Narendra Modi also spoke with the two Union ministers from Kerala, Suresh Gopi and George Kurien, about the current situation. Modi has instructed BJP president J P Nadda to mobilize party workers in the region to assist with the ongoing relief efforts. PM Modi announces ex-gratia

The Prime Minister has announced an ex-gratia of Rs 2 lakh from PMNRF for the ex-gratia of Rs 2 lash from PMINRF for the next of kin of each deceased in the land-slides in parts of Wayanad. The injured would be given Rs. 50,000.

Leader of the Opposition and former Lok

Sabha MP from Wayanad Rahul Gandhi also expressed condolences to the bereaved families who have lost their loved ones. "I am deeply anguished by the massive landslides near Meppadi in Wayanad. My heartfelt condolences go out to the bereaved families who have lost their loved ones. I hope those still trapped are brought to safety soon," he said.

The Congress leader said that he have have spoken to the Kerala Chief Minister and the



Wayanad District Collector, who assured me that rescue operations are underway. "I have requested them to ensure coordination with all agencies, set up a control room, and inform us of any assistance needed for the relief efforts. I will speak to Union Ministers and request them to provide all assistance possible to Wayanad. I urge all UDF workers to assist the administration in the rescue and relief operations," he added.

Five ministers being deployed in Wayanad Forest Minister AK Saseendran has arrived at the site, and Minister Ramachandran Kadanappally is expected to arrive shortly. Revenue Minister K Rajan, Public Works Minister Mohammad Riyas, and Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes Minister OR Kelu will travel to Wayanad by air from Thiruvanan-thapuram. Opposition Leader VD Satheesan is also set to depart for Wayanad.

According to the Kerala Chief Minister's Office, 250 members of Fire and Rescue, Civil Defence, NDRF, and the Local Emergency Response Team are currently involved in the rescue operation in Wayanad's Chooral Mala. An additional NDRF team has also been directed to reach the site immediately.

Mamata Banerjee slams Centre after Jharkhand train derailment: Is this governance

SC grants bail to NCP leader Nawab Malik on medical grounds

New Delhi: The Supreme Court today granted bail on medical grounds to former Maharashtra minister Nawab Malik in a money laundering case.

A bench of justices Bela M Trivedi and Satish Chandra Sharma took note of the submissions of a counsel, appearing for Malik, that he was suffering from various ailments.

The top court said medical bail to Mailk will be valid till disposal of the regular bail plea before the Bombay High Court.

Additional Solicitor General SV Raju, appearing for the ED, did not oppose grant of bail, and said the interim medical bail may be made permanent.

The ED had arrested Malik in February 2022 in the case allegedly linked to the activities of fugitive gangster Dawood Ibrahim and his associates.

Malik had sought relief from the high court, claiming he was suffering from a chronic kidney disease apart from various other ailments. He also sought bail on merit.

The ED's case against Malik is based on an FIR filed by the National Investigation Agency (NIA) against Ibrahim, a designated global terrorist and a key accused in the 1993 Mumbai serial bomb blasts, and his associates under the Unlawful Activities (Prevention)



Which rules were flouted by Delhi coaching centre where 3 students died?

Classrooms and libraries in basements, no proper drainage facilities are some of the rampant safety violations found in several coaching centres across Delhi. These violations were also found at Rau's IAS Study Circle coaching institute in Rajinder Nagar, where three civil service aspirants lost their lives on Saturday evening due to flooding in the basement.

The victims, Shreya Yadav from Uttar Pradesh, Tanya Soni from Telangana, and Navin Dalwin from Kerala, were caught in the deluge after heavy rains inundated the basement of the centre. The incident has ignited widespread student protests, with protesters accusing local authorities of severe negligence in ensuring the safety standards of educational institutions.

Meanwhile, the total goods and services tax collected (GST) from coaching centres across the country has more than doubled in the last five years, according to the government data shared with the Rajya Sabha. From 2019-20, the total GST collected from coaching was Rs 2,240.73 crore. It grew to Rs 5,517.45 crore in 2023-24.

After the Delhi High Court took note of the Mukherjee Nagar fire incident in June last year, the Delhi Police submitted a status report in which they mentioned that as many as 583 coaching institutes were running in Delhi. According to



the report, out of 583 coaching institutes, only 67 have fire safety certificates, while 516 institutes do not have a fire safety certificate.

The use of the basement shall be subject to clearance from the fire authorities and other statutory bodies as per the relevant provisions of the Master Plan of Delhi (MPD) 2021 and the Unified Building Bye-Laws, as amended from time to time.

As per Unified Building Bye-Laws 2016, for educational buildings (schools or colleges), a basement or cellar room may be designed, constructed, altered, converted, or used for the purpose of study or instruction, provided it meets fire safety requirements.

As per rules laid down in the Unified Building Bye-Laws for Delhi, 2016, the construction of the basement shall be allowed by the Sanctioning Authority in accordance with the land use and other provisions specified under the Master Plan for Delhi/Zonal Development Plan.

1. Every basement should, in every part, be at least 2.4 m in height from the floor to the soffit of the beam and 2.4 m in minimum width.

2. Adequate ventilation shall be provided for the basement.

3. The maximum finish level of the ground floor above the basement shall be up to 1.5 m and shall be measured with respect to the average surrounding ground level, open level, or setback level.

4. An adequate arrangement shall be made such that surface drainage does not enter the basement.

5. The walls and floors of the basement shall be watertight and be so designed that the effects of the surrounding soil and moisture, if any, are taken into account in the design and adequate damproofing treatment is given.

6. Access to the basement shall be either from the main or alternate staircase providing access to the building.

7. For all types of buildings having more than one basement, fire clearance will have to be obtained.

The coaching centre was using the basement as a library, even though civic authorities had said it could be used as storage. The coaching centre received a No Objection Certificate (NOC) earlier this month, in which clearance was given for the three-storey building, a stilt parking space beneath the building, and a basement, which was supposed to be used as a storage area.

The owner of the coaching centre admitted that the basement of the institute did not have any drainage facilities. It has also been reported that it had only one entry and exit

As per reports, the coaching industry in India is worth Rs 58,088 crore, of which civil services coaching institutes contribute Rs 3,000 crore. Delhi is often considered the hub of UPSC-CSE coaching.

Lakhs of students from several states, including Bihar, Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, and the southern parts of the country, come to Delhi to study in coaching institutes in Rajinder Nagar and Mukherjee Nagar. In a reply to Rajya Sabha on

July 24, 2024, the Department of Revenue shared the GST collection of Rs 5517.45 crore from coaching institutions in the financial year 2023–24.

Roadside Encroachments continues in Mohali

Mohali: Illegal encroachments outside showrooms, at marketplaces, roadsides have become a common affair. We often see that owners of showrooms encroach upon public many vendors have encroachment over spaces on roadsides leading to regular traffic congestion.

Residents of Mohali raises a question does the concerned officials really have any concrete policy against roadside encroachments in the city? Unfortunately, with the present situation of roads in Mohali it seems concerned officials have no such plan so far, as a result illegal grabbing/ encroachment of roadside is continuing unabated in almost every part of Mohali.

Residents stated without carrying out a massive anti-encroachment drive, the Mohali Municipal Corporation would have no meaning at all. Despite the fact that the Mohali Municipal Corporation constructed pathways for convenience of pedestrians, a majority of them have been encroached by the street vendors, no checks have been conducted to restrict such vendors from illegally occupying the footpaths stated residents.

Residents also add that the number street vendors occupying pavement had increased significantly in recent months. A senior citizen added encroachments are so massive in the evening that pedestrians are forced to step on the road. "Although the encroachments are comparatively less in the morning, it still causes more inconvenience to the early morning walkers. Some vendors set up food stalls with plastic sheets tied to serve as a shelter during evenings. With many public spots located in the area, traffic snarls are a common sight. Ludhiana: Rajya Sabha MP Sanjeev Arora raised the issue of underage drinking and driving across the country and gave suggestions to the government to deal with the issue in the ongoing session of Rajya Sabha.

While expressing his concerns over instances of underage drinking and driving in the country, Arora said a recent road accident in Pune shook the country. He termed this road accident of frightening significance. He added according to RTI information, out of 100 pubs operating in Pune only 23 were licensed.

Arora pointed out that underage drinking and driving is a major concern. He said in Delhi itself, there is 573 percent increase in challans for underage driving compared to last year in first quarter of this current fiscal.

He further mentioned in his address that fake IDs are another major challenge to curb underage drinking. Arora recommended specific measures to the government to overcome the present situation. He stressed the need for carrying out regular and surprise inspections of establishments. He advocated for stricter penalties for those violating the

law by serving alcohol to underage customers.

Further, Arora suggested initiating public awareness campaigns to educate both the young and the public highlighting legal consequences, health risks, and potential for addiction associated with underage alcohol consumption. Arora suggested to the government to collaborate with the hospitality industry, educational institutions and NGOs to develop a strategy to address underage drinking. He suggested arranging training for servers on identifying fake IDs and refusing service to minors, as well as educational programmes in schools and colleges about the dangers of underage drinking.

Arora further suggested the need to give more power to common citizens and empowering them by developing mobile apps through which they can click pictures and geotag the area of the offenders thereby helping the law enforcement officials.

Concluding his address, he said he believes that a multipronged approach involving stricter enforcement, public awareness initiatives and collaboration with stakeholders is essential to effectively address this issue.

BJP jailed AAP ministers who did good work in Delhi: Bhaqwant Mann

Chandigarh: Punjab Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann launched a scathing attack on the BJP-led central government, accusing it of imprisoning Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) leaders who have made significant improvements in Delhi's education and health sectors.

"Modi ji loots for almost four years and in the end gives a lollipop to the public by reducing the price of LPG cylinder by Rs 100," Mann

Ahead of assembly elections in

Haryana, the Punjab Chief Minister warned voters against falling for such lollipops. He appealed to them to bring AAP to power in the state. "This time Haryana

has jhaadu (broom, AAP's poll symbol). Earlier only houses and shops were cleaned with a jhaa-

du, this time under the leadership of Arvind Kejriwal, the whole of India will be cleaned," he asserted. AAP earlier announced it will be fighting the Haryana assembly elections on its own. The Arvind Kejriwal-led party had previously allied with the Congress and gained one seat in the Lok Sabha polls in the state. Now it will be contesting in all 90 assembly seats solo.

Central team inspects site of electrocution in Chandigarh's Sector 8

Chandigarh: A two-member team of technical experts from the Central Electricity Authority, Delhi, today inspected the spot where a 17-yearold boy was electrocuted in Sector 8 here on July 17.

Sources said the team would take a day or two to submit the report to the UT Administration after getting approval from their authorities. The victim, Mayank of Sector 7, was the son of the Deputy Director in Enforcement Directorate here. While crossing the railings next to a transformer, he came into contact with it and was electrocuted.

On the directions of Punjab Governor and UT Administrator Banwarilal Purohit, Deputy Commissioner Vinay Pratap Singh had on July 19 ordered a magisterial inquiry into the tragic fatal incident. SDM (Central) Naveen was entrusted with the task to conduct and complete the magisterial inquiry in 10 days by associating technical experts in the field of power from Delhi.

Purohit had visited the site of the incident to assess the situation first-



hand and instructed a comprehensive investigation to determine the cause of death, identify any lapses by officials, and recommend necessary precautions to prevent such occurrences in the future.

The Administrator had expressed his displeasure at the uncovered and exposed fuses of the power transformers and instructed the Engineering Department to take immediate measures to ensure the safety of residents in vicinity of electric transformers and poles in Chandigarh to prevent cases of electrocution.

He emphasised the urgency for the electricity wing of the Engineering Department to secure or cover areas around transformers to prevent such incidents and mandated strict adherence to all safety regulations set by the Power Ministry.

Purohit had issued strict instructions to both the civil and police administrations to take stringent

action against those found responsible for the boy's death. He also called for fixing accountability within the department concerned.

An Executive Engineer and a Sub-Divisional Engineer were placed under suspension pending the inquiry.

Expedite disposal of timber stock to prevent rotting: Himachal CM Sukhvinder Sukhu to Forest Corpn

Shimla: Chief Minister Sukhvinder Sukhu today directed the Forest Corporation to expedite disposal of timber wood stock from its depots to prevent rotting and resultant loss-

The Chief Minister today presided over the 214th meeting of the Board of Directors of Himachal Pradesh State Forest Development Corporation (HPFSDC) here today. He directed the officers to take necessary measures to expedite the disposal of the timber wood stock accumulated in the corporation's depots so that it could be prevented from rotting.

The Chief Minister said that it was for the first time, the HPFSDC would engage in mining activities from the Beas river after obtaining FCA clearance.

Additionally, he directed the corporation to blacklist defaulting contractors and initiate recovery proceedings against them besides barring them from participating in future tenders.

A total of 618 trees were damaged in Shimla city during last year's monsoon fury, the sale of which has brought an earning of Rs 2.50 crore for the corporation. He commended the corporation's efforts for earning profits of Rs. 2.17 crore during the financial year 2021-22, Rs 8 crore during 2022-23 and Rs 10.04 crore in 2023-24.

Sukhu said that 100 Van Veers

would be engaged to address the staff shortage in the Forest Corporation. He assured that the state government would provide full cooperation to strengthen the Forest Corporation, aiming to make it a self-reliant and profitable organisa-

Sukhu also asked to explore the possibility of delegating powers to Divisional Forest Officers (DFOs) along with the officers of the corporation to cut down trees coming in the ways of linear projects after the first stage clearance of FCA so as to avoid unnecessary delays.

The Board of Directors gave its approval to grant a bonus to the employees of the Corporation for the year 2022-23, benefiting about 227 employees and to increase daily wages to Rs. 400, benefiting the corporation's daily wagers.

It was also decided to grant another instalment of 4 per cent DA to all employees from April 1, 2024 and to regularise 80 employees who have completed two years of contractual service.

The Corporation presented a cheque of Rs 51 lakh to the Chief Minister for the CM Relief Fund. Vice Chairman HPFSDC Kehar Singh Khachi, Principal Secretary Forest Amandeep Garg and Secretary to Chief Minister Rakesh Kanwar along with senior officers of the HPFSDC attended the meeting.

PU looks to industry for commercialising patents

Chandigarh: Panjab University (PU) was granted 47 patents from January 2023 to April this year. During the year 2022, 12 patents were granted to the university. The highest number of patents came in the field of pharmaceutical science.

"Efforts are being made to connect researchers with industrial sector so that technologies developed can be commercialised," said Vice-Chancellor Renu Vig. She added that during the assessment period 2017-22 for NAAC accreditation, the university had published 55 researches and was granted patents for nearly 30.

"Earlier, faculty members published pa-pers in journals rather than filing patents," said the VC when asked about the rise in the number patents granted to the univer-

Giving an insight on university's plans to boost research and commercialise final products, Prof Manu Sharma, Director, Centre for Industry Institute Partnership Programme, said, "We are organising a transfer of technology conference in asso-ciation with Punjab State Council for Science and Technology on November 22 and 23 this year. Each scientist will be given 10 minutes for articulation of his/her patent before people from industries. The aim is to transfer the invention from academia to industry

Dr Indu Pal Kaur, professor, University Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences, was granted five patents as the primary inventor of the product. On November 9 last



year, she was granted the patent in association with Atin Kalra for orally dispersible taste masked formulations of bitter drugs. "Most antiviral drugs are very bitter with poor bioavailability. There is hardly any organised research happening in the area to design child-friendly dosages that can en-sure delivery of efficient and correct dose to kids. This technology describes fast dissolving mini tablets and films for bitter antiviral drugs," said Prof Kaur. Prof Dr Maninder Karan, Prof Dr Karan

Vasisht and junior research fellow Meenakshi Verma of the department were granted patent for 'Novel polyherbal composition for prevention and treatment of inflammation and arthritis'

"Arthritis is a painful, chronic and inflammatory disease of both old and young. It requires long-term treatment. Sometimes, the treatment has to be taken throughout life. Most treatments have serious side-effects, most common being gastric effects. This invention is based on an innovative

and unique natural remedy which is as effective as synthetic drugs but without any gastric side-effect, rather it provides additional gastric protection and can be taken orally or applied locally, said Dr Karan. Prof Seema Kapoor of Dr

SS Bhatnagar University Institute of Chemical Engineering & Technology, PU, in association with Professor

Uma Batra of the Department of Metallurgical and Materials Engineering, Punjab Engineering College, was granted a patent for 'Multi-substituted calcium phosphate for biomedical applications and the method of synthesis thereof' in February this year. Prof Kapoor said the patented product offers significant benefits for treating various bone and dental-related issues and can be commercially manufactured.

Panjab University is organising an Investors' Summit from March 3 to March 5 next year, registrations for which would close on August 31. Entrepreneurs will pitch their business plans before investors. For participation in the summit, business plan has to be around some patented technology. The Department of Science & Technology-sponsored Technology Enabling Centre of the PU will conduct 10 training sessions and give as many assignments so as to prepare budding entrepreneurs for the summit.

Kumbhra sub-centre not in pink of health

Mohali: The health and wellness centre at Kumbhra village here is unique in itself as patients and pregnant women have to go up a dozen stairs for consultation. Around 8 to 10 pregnant women visit this facility daily, laborously climbing up the narrow stairs in shabby, unhygienic conditions. Broken toilet seats and waste furniture greet them at the cave-like entrance here.

The sub-centre is housed in village panchayat dharamshala for a decade now. Decades-old scrap is dumped in the hall on the ground floor of the building, the first floor has three-room dispensary with a makeshift toilet and the top floor has a dharamshala.

The climb-up is an ardous task for pregnant women who come along with their kids. Not only this, the narrow stairs with steep gradient has uneven steps which pose the risk of tripping while climbing up or down.

In need of instant medical treatment and emergency, locals consider it no less than a dispensary. Expectant mothers visit here for



consultation and medical advice. Nearly 100 expectant and new mothers are registered

A community health officer and ANMs (auxiliary nursing midwife) are posted here. In times of cholera outbreak in the village, it acts as a makeshift medical camp with twothree lady doctors and nurses

Parul, Rekha, and Seema, who had come for a check-up, said it was very tiresome and risky going up and down as visitors jostle for space in the narrow staircase. "Pregnant women along with their children face great difficulty handling their kids here," said a female visitor. "The surroundings are dirty and unhygienic. This is not how a dispensary looks like. The medical staff's silence on the state of affairs says all," said another

Imagine the number of visitors here as a medical camp was set up to attend to patients with cholera-like symptoms. From the look of the sub-centre, it is clear that it once started as a makeshift arrangement, but with time and official apathy, it became a permanent fixture.

Smiles, handshakes and selfies: Virat Kohli greets fans at Colombo airport

The ODI side has started training under the assistant coach Abhishek Nayar in Colombo. Meanwhile, the other players from the T20Is will also join the team after completion of the series. India lead the series 2-0 against Sri Lanka in the shortest format and will aim for a clean-sweep as they play the 3rd T20I on July 30, Today.

Life on Earth began 1.5 billion years earlier than previously thought

New Delhi: An international team of scientists has uncovered environmental evidence of the earliest experiments in the evolution of complex life on Earth. This finding, led by researchers from Cardiff University, challenges the widely accepted timeline that animals first emerged around 635 million years ago. The team discovered evidence of a much earlier ecosystem in the Franceville Basin near Gabon on the Atlantic coast of Central Africa, dating back over 1.5 billion years earlier than previously

Their study, published in Precambrian Research, describes a unique episode of underwater volcanic activity following the collision of two continents, creating a nutrient-rich environment conducive to early biological evolution.

Dr. Ernest Chi Fru, the lead author and a Reader at Cardiff University's School of Earth and Environmental Sciences, highlighted the significance of phosphorus availability in the environment as a key component in the evolution of life. "The availability of phosphorus in the

environment is thought to be a key component in the evolution of life on Earth, especially in the transition from simple single-cell organisms to complex organisms like animals and plants," Dr. Chi Fru explained.

The Cardiff-led team identified a link between environmental change and nutrient enrichment, which may have triggered the evolution of large-sized fossils of macroorganisms from this period. These fossils, the earliest of their kind in the geologic record, have been a subject of debate among scientists.

Geochemical analysis of marine sedimentary rocks deposited 2.1 billion



years ago provided new insights into these large fossils. Dr. Chi Fru elaborated, "We think that the underwater volcanoes, which followed the collision and suturing of the Congo and S£o Francisco cratons into one main body, further restricted and even cut off this section of water from the global ocean to create a nutrient-rich shallow marine inland sea." This isolated environment allowed cyanobacterial photosynthesis to thrive, leading to the oxygenation of local seawater and the generation of a substantial food resource. This, in turn, provided sufficient energy to promote an increase in body size and more complex behavior in primitive animal-like life forms.

However, the restricted nature of this water mass and the hostile conditions beyond it likely prevented these early life forms from spreading globally.

The study suggests a two-step evolution of complex life on Earth: the first major rise in atmospheric oxygen content 2.1 billion years ago, followed by a second rise 1.5 billion years later.

This discovery not only pushes back the timeline for the emergence of complex life but also provides crucial insights into the environmental conditions that facilitated this significant evolutionary leap.

Brands face legal action for using Olympic medalists' images without sponsorship

New Delhi: Brands using photos, images, and videos of Indian Olympic medal winners in congratulatory advertisements or messages without sponsoring the athletes are set to receive legal notices for infringing on personality rights, executives representing the athletes.

executives representing the athletes. Manu Bhaker, the 22-year-old shooter who secured a bronze medal at the Paris Olympics, has seen a surge in congratulatory messages from brands that are not associated with her.

According to Neerav Tomar, Managing Director of IOS Sports & Entertainment, which manages Bhaker, "Almost two dozen brands not affiliated with Manu have released congratulatory ads on social media featuring her images. This constitutes unauthorised 'moment marketing,' and legal notices will be served to these brands."

Among the companies that have featured Bhaker's image are Bajaj Foods, LIC, FIITJEE, Oakwood International School, Praneet Group, Radha TMT, Apricot Bioscience, Kineto, Xtrabrick Realtors, and Parul Ayurved Hospital. Efforts to reach these companies for comments yielded no responses, ET said. Moneycontrol could not independently verify the report.

Bhaker endorses sports gear and fitness fashion company Performax Activewear, while negotiations are on with several other brands for endorsements or sponsorships.

The issue of unauthorised use of athletes images is becoming increasingly com-



mon, executives said.

"Brands that do not sponsor our athletes cannot legally use their images in advertisements. If they do, we will take strict legal action," said a spokesperson from Baseline Ventures, representing boxer Nikhat Zareen and badminton players Chirag Shetty and Satwiksairaj Rankireddy.

Legal experts say while laws exist to protect personality rights, enforcement is often slow and not as robust as in markets like Europe or the US.

"There should be immediate legal remedies for such cases. The government needs to address this issue, especially given that these are national champions with significant personal brand value," another sports management executive was quoted as saying by ET.


While the laws are in place, they are not comprehensive enough and celebrities have not pursued enough litigation compared to their counterparts in other regions, experts say.

Andhra Pradesh government to soon issue Pattadar Passbooks with official seals

Amaravati: The Andhra Pradesh government has decided to issue Pattadar Passbooks to land owners with official seals, Chief Minister N Chandrababu Naidu has said.

The decision was made on July 29, when, during a meeting with officials, the Chief Minister said former Chief Minister Jagan Mohan Reddy had wasted Rs 15 crore for getting his own photos printed on the passbook.

"The State Government, as promised during the electioneering and as per the demand of the people, has decided to issue passbooks with official seal. The officers have already submitted a copy of the passbook carrying the official seal," an official release stated.

"Arrangements have been made in such a way that if the QR Code is scanned all the details of the property, the address of the property, and the maps clearly show the exact location of the property. The previous government had spent funds heavily for the survey of agricultural lands in the name of resurvey," the release added.



Announcing the new passbooks, Naidu said," Though the Centre has never mentioned about the issue of laying stones in the directions for resurvey, Mr Jagan has prepared granite stones only for carving his pictures."

"Exercise is on by the government on what to do with the 77 lakh granite stones carrying Mr Jagan's pictures,' he said.

The tentative estimates to delete these pics from the stones cost another Rs 15 crore. The public money amounting to Rs 700 crore is going waste due to Mr Jagan's thirst for his pictures," the Chief Minister said.

Following the announcement, state's Education Minister, Nara Lokesh, in an X post said the Pattadar Passbooks will carry the emblem of Andhra Pradesh.

He also slammed Jagan Mohan Reddy's party, YSRCP, and alleged his government plunged the state into a financial crisis.

"Dear people of Andhra Pradesh, Your land Pattadar's Passbook will now carry AP's Emblem (Rajamudra)," Nara Lokesh tweeted.

The YSRCP government not only plunged our State into a financial crisis but also spent 700 Cr. to get the 'Axe' CM's image printed everywhere, including on your land passbooks. This wasted money which belonged to you," he added.

"Our NDA government is devoted to you and committed to protecting your lands and dignity. This step is yet another affirmation of this promise," Nara Lokesh wrote on X.

'Rail Minister is Reel Minister': Opposition rips Centre over train accidents

Shiv Sena (UBT) MP Priyanka Chaturvedi questioned the government's response to increasingly frequent instances of rail-related mishaps, accusing it of "shameful apathy" "With several deaths and no accountability till date, I guess this also won't have any im-

pact. Announce compensation, promise enquiry and move on to another PR Instagram reel," Chaturvedi said. She further attacked Railways Minister Ash-

wini Vaishnaw, calling him a "Reel minister," and criticised overcrowding in trains, stating, "People are travelling in toilets but the government is not aslamed." the government is not ashamed.

Trinamool Congress leaders Sushmita Dev and Sagarika Ghose accused the Railway Ministry of zero accountability, with Dev stating, "This is becoming the new normal. Accountability of @AshwiniVaishnaw ji is zero. The GOI has no answers whatsoever. Ghose wondered how many more train accidents it would take for the Centre to take action, saying, "How many more train accidents shall it take for the Modi government to wake up from its slumber? People are suffering morels are hair actions." are suffering, people are being put through hardships and misery while the Modi government continues to escape accountability and responsibility for rail safety."

The Jharkhand Mukti Morcha (JMM) also slammed the Centre, urging the Railways Minister to focus on railways instead of making social media reels. The ruling party also distanced itself from the accident and said Chief Minister Hemant Soren and the INDIA bloc were not involved in any way.

The accident occurred when at least 18 coaches of the Howrah-Mumbai Mail derailed in Jharkhand's Seraikela-Kharsawan district early today.

boy were arrested for allegedly killing the girl's mother in West Bengal's North 24 Parganas district. The arrested boy was a friend of the girl. The incident came to light after the 14-year-old girl's father lodged a complaint, claiming that his daughter had killed his wife along with one of her friends.

The crime was committed at their house on June 6, the father claimed. He said that he filed the complaint after over a month because both the minors had threatened to kill him if he filed a case.

The man alleged that his daughter was in a relationship with the boy, whom she met on social media, for over one-and-a-half years.

However, the victim often used to scold her daughter for the same and did not approve of her relationship,

Following that, both of them decided to kill the girl's mother, he said in the complaint.

The girl called her friend to her house on the night of June 6, and the

boy allegedly strangulated her mother and punched her in her chest.

When the girl's father woke up, the boy allegedly pushed him out of bed. The boy then threatened to murder him if he revealed the incident to anyone.

The man said that he filed his wife's death as a natural death and cremated her in the afternoon.

The minors were arrested after the man's complaint and will be produced before the Juvenile Justice Board.

Police said that both of them had confessed to the crime.

A case has been registered, and further investigation is on, police said.

Puja Khedkar got disability certificate despite no nod from physiotherapist

Pune: Several discrepancies have emerged in the locomotor disability certificate issued by a civic hospital near Pune to controversial IAS probationary officer Puja Khedkar, documents accessed exclusively.

Khedkar, who is facing scrutiny over allegations of manipulating disability and OBC certificates to gain entry into the civil services, was issued a 7% locomotor disability certificate by Yashwantrao Chavan Memorial (YCM) Hospital in August 2022.

Obtained exclusive documents exposing inconsistencies in the disability certification practices at YCM Hospital. The documents show that despite the physiotherapy department at YCM reporting no disability, the hospital administration issued Khedkar a certificate indicating a 7% locomotor disability in her left knee.

The Pune Collector's Office has initiated a probe into the matter following instructions from the 'DIVYANG' Welfare Commissionerate.



While applying for her disability certificate, Puja Khedkar had told YCM hospital doctors about a minor accident in 2018 that led to an injury to her left knee. However, as per the exclusive documents obtained by India Today, no medical records from that year were checked, and no MRI scan was performed during her examination. On August 23, 2022, Khedkar visited

YCM Hospital to secure a disability certificate, using what was later found to be false address proof from a fake ration card.

The next day, Khedkar got a locomo-

tor disability certificate that said she had 7% instability in her left knee due to an anterior cruciate ligament (ACL) tear from a minor accident in 2018.

When Khedkar visited the physiotherapy department, the findings did not match the initial diagnosis. The physiotherapists found no systemic disability in her knee and did not confirm the 7% instability noted by the resident doctor.

This has raised serious concerns about the accuracy of the disability certification process at YCM Hospital.

The 2023-batch trainee IAS officer has also been booked by the Delhi Police's Crime Branch for allegedly submitting false information to UPSC about her identity to avail more attempts at the civil service exams than she is eligible

The Centre has also formed a single-member committee to examine all documents submitted by Khedkar.

The call, held on Monday evening (local time), lasted over three hours and saw top Democratic officials, including Transportation Secretary Pete Buttigieg, Minnesota Governor Tim Walz, and Illinois Governor

JB Pritzker, also present. The Zoom call was marked by a mix of humour and serious discussion, with partici-pants taking swipes at Republican nominee Donald Trump and his running mate JD

Governor Walz, a potential running mate for

Harris, said it was an opportunity for white men to show that Trump did not represent all white men, while Governor Pritzker joked about joining a call called "Couches Against Trump, better known as CATS", a reference to Vance's "childless cat ladies" attack on prominent Democrats.

Actor Josh Gad pointed out that the 'White Dudes for Harris' call was a stark contrast to the testosterone-heavy Republican National Convention. "They have Kid Rock, Kevin Sorbo and a dolphin aficionado, and we have the Hulk, Samwise Gamgee, Luke Skywalker and Mayor Pete just on the Zoom," he

said. The call was part of a series of Zoom gatherings aimed at raising money and rallying support for Harris after US President Joe Biden announced his withdrawal from the presidential

race and endorsed her.
Previous Zoom calls, such as 'White
Women for Harris', have also seen an overwhelming turnout, with over 164,000 attendees. These events have featured celebrities who previously supported Biden's campaign, demonstrating the need for Harris to appeal to di-

verse segments of the population. The campaign has welcomed the assistance, with communications director Michael Ty-ler stating, "Winning campaigns are pow-

ered by real, organic support."

After she became the Democratic Party's

Trump calls Kamala Harris 'worse candidate' than Biden for presidential polls

Washington: Former president and Republican presidential candidate Donald Trump has called his likely Democratic opponent, Vice President Kamala Harris, a "worse candidate" than President Joe Biden, who she replaced more than a week ago.
"I think she (Harris) is the worst candi-

date than him (Biden). She is far more radical left," Trump told Fox News host Laura Ingraham in an interview on Monday, his first after Harris, 59, became the presumptive nominee of the Democratic Party.

Harris officially declared her candidacy after incumbent President Biden withdrew from the race for a second term on July 20. She is expected to be officially declared as the presidential candidate by the Democrats next

"I thought she was a little younger. I mean, she's 60 years old. I didn't realise she was 60. She's talking a big game. But her game is pretty bad. She was the border czar. She's trying to pretend that she wasn't," Trump said. She was for defunding the police. She was for open borders. She was for having anybody come in. Now I notice that they're actually saying they want to have immunity for everybody that came into the country, and they want to have citizenship," Trump alleged, asserting that giving citizenship to everybody would destroy the country.

"It's in such bad shape. Our country

has never been in a position like this. In addition to which we could end up in a third world war. We have 20 million people that have come into the country. I would say by now 20 (million) is probably going over that number," he

Trump reiterated his allegations that the Democratic establishment staged a coup against Biden.

"They staged a coup against the president of the United States. They went to him and told him 'You are leaving. You are way down in the poll'. Seventeen points, I think," he said.

"It's like you're in a fight with some-body, and you're really winning, and they take him out and they put some-body else in. Nobody ever heard of this before," he added.

"This is a coup. They took him. They said even though you got 14 million votes, you're out. And he said 'I am not going out'â€æThey took him out. He was losing badly, so they took him out. He wants something to say. He's sitting there with nothing to do, nobody to talk to. They threw him out. This was a coup, the first one of the president of the United States," Trump said.

Trump also said that while he "probably" will debate Harris, he "could also make a case" to avoid a face-to-face confrontation with her, CNBC News

After the interview's broadcast, the Harris for President campaign said Ingraham practically begged Trump on Fox News to commit to debating

"Why won't Donald Trump give a straight answer on debating Vice President Harris? It's clear from tonight's question-dodging: he's scared he'll have to defend his running mate's weird attacks on women or his own calls to end elections in America in a debate against the vice president," said Harris for President spokesperson Ammar Moussa.

Vice President Harris will be on the debate stage (on) September 10th. Donald Trump can show up, or not," Moussa said.

US works to prevent Israeli counterattack on Lebanon amid threat of all-out war

New Delhi: The United States is scrambling to prevent a full-blown war between Israel and Lebanon, as tensions soar following a deadly rocket attack on the Israeli-occupied

Golan Heights that killed 12 children. Reuters reports citing sources that the US is leading a diplomatic push to dissuade Israel from targeting Beirut or critical Lebanese infrastructure in retaliation for Saturday's attack, which Israel blamed on the Iranbacked Hezbollah group. Hezbollah has denied involvement.

Israeli officials, while vowing a harsh response, have indicated a desire to avoid a wider conflict. Two officials told Reuters that Israel is preparing for a limited military operation, possibly lasting several days. The focus of Washington's diplomacy has

been to convince Tel Aviv to limit its retaliation, Reuters reported citing officials. This includes urging against strikes on densely populated areas like Beirut and its Hezbollah-dominated southern suburbs, as well as key infrastructure.

Lébanese officials, including Foreign Minister Abdallah Bou Habib and Deputy Parliament Speaker Elias Bou Saab, have publicly appealed for restraint and warned of potential consequences for Israel if it targets civilian areas.

However, both acknowledged that an Israeli

retaliation is likely. While expecting an Israeli attack, they expressed hope for a limited escalation on both sides.

"Israel will escalate in a limited way and Hezbollah will respond in a limited way â€æ These are the assurances we've received," Bou Habib said. The US, Lebanon, and Israel are engaged

in intense diplomatic talks to contain the situation. However, two Western diplomats told Reuters that Israel has not committed to avoiding strikes on Beirut, its suburbs, or

civilian targets. Meanwhile, Iran's President Masoud Pezeshkian has warned that any Israeli attack on Lebanon would have "serious consequences" for the Jewish nation.
Despite the heightened tensions, US Nation-

2 children dead in 'Ferocious' knife attack at UK dance workshop, teen arrested

London: At least two children were killed, and nine people injured during a "ferocious" knife attack at a dance workshop in northwest England, police said. A 17-year-old boy has been arrested, and a knife seized after the bloody attack.

A witness described seeing bloodied children running from a community center where a Taylor Swift-themed dance and yoga event for children aged about 6 to 11 was taking place in Southport, a seaside town near Liverpool. An advertisement for the event promised "a morning of Tay-lor Swift-themed yoga, dance and bracelet

making."
Prime Minister Keir Starmer called the attack "horrendous and deeply shocking."
Merseyside Police said officers were called at about noon to an address in Southport, a seaside town of about 1,00,000 people near Liverpool. It called it a "major incident" but said there was no wider threat to the public. Detectives were not treating the attack as terror-related, the force said.

The suspect, who has not been identified, lived in a village about 5 miles (8 kilometers) from the site of the attack, police said. The North West Ambulance Service said medics treated eight people with stab inju-



ries. The injured were taken to local hospitals, including a children's hospital.

Bare Varathan, who owns a shop down the street, said he saw between seven and 10 bleeding children running from the Hart Space, a community hub that offers classes for expectant mothers, babies and children. "They had been stabbed here, here, here,

" he said, indicating the neck back and chest. "They were all aged about 10. One of them was really seriously iniured."

Ryan Carney, who lives with his mother in the street, said his mother saw emergency

workers carrying children "covered in red, covered in blood. She said she could see the stab wounds in the backs of the children.

'All this stuff never really happens around here," he said. "You hear of it, stabbings and stuff like that in major cities, your Manchesters, your Londons. This is sunny Southport. That's what people call it. The sun's out. It's a lovely place to be." Britain's worst attack on

children occurred in 1996, when 43-year-old Thomas Hamilton shot 16

kindergarten pupils and their teacher dead in a school gymnasium in Dunblane, Scotland. The U.K. subsequently banned the private ownership of almost all handguns.

Mass shootings and murders with firearms are rare in Britain, where knives were used in about 40 per cent of homicides in the year to March 2023. Several headline-grabbing attacks and a recent rise in knife crime have stoked anxieties and led to calls for the government to do more to clamp down on bladed weapons.

Venezuela snaps ties with 7 nations over poll riqqinq claims after Maduro win



Caracas: Venezuela has severed diplomatic relations with seven Latin American nations that questioned the legitimacy of President Nicolas Maduro's election victory, expelling their diplomatic missions and withdrawing its own staff from those countries.

Maduro's Foreign Minister Yvan Gil ordered the immediate departure of diplomatic personnel from Argentina, Chile, Costa Rica, Peru, Panama, the Dominican Republic, and Uruguay, citing "interventionist acts" by these nations.

"Venezuela reserves all legal and political rights to enforce, preserve and defend our inalienable right to self-determination," the Maduro government said in a statement, according to the Miami Herald. "We will confront all actions that threaten the climate of peace and coexistence.

The move comes after these countries expressed concerns over the results of Sunday's presidential election, which Maduro won with 51.2 per cent of the votes according to the regime-controlled electoral council.

Opposition candidate Edmundo Gonzalez Urrutia and his coalition claim they have obtained 73.2 per cent of the voting tallies, disputing the official results. Urrutia's ally and opposition leader Maria Corina Machado argued that a review of voting records shows a "mathematically irreversible" lead for him, with 6.27 million votes to Maduro's 2.75 million, the Associated Press reported.

Thousands of Venezuelans took to the streets to protest what they called a sto-

len election, chanting "Freedom, freedom!" and "This government is going to fall!" Security forces responded with tear gas and rubber bullets.

The opposition has vowed to continue challenging the election results, which they claim were tainted by fraud and political intimidation.

The diplomatic fallout has exposed a deep divide in Latin America, with some nations supporting Maduro's government and others rejecting the election outcome.

Peru recalled its ambassador to Caracas because of the "very serious" results announced in Venezuela, while Costa Rica's President Rodrigo Chaves rejected what he called the "fraudulent" outcome

Chilean President Gabriel Boric called Maduro's victory "hard to believe". while Colombia's Foreign Minister Luis Gilberto Murillo called for an "independent audit" of the result. Argentina's right-wing President Javier Milei wrote in a social media post: "DICTATOR MADURO, OUT!!!"

On the other hand, allies Cuba, Nicaragua, Bolivia, and Honduras have congratulated Maduro on his victory.

The United States, Britain, and the European Union have expressed concerns over the election's legitimacy, calling for transparency and a fair count of

US Secretary of State Antony Blinken stated that the announced result "does not reflect the will or the votes of the Venezuelan people."

Russia and China, however, have congratulated Maduro on his victory.

Woman sent to Jail For overfeeding 53 Kg dog to death in New Zealand

New Zealand: A woman from New Zealand was sentenced to two months in prison after her dog, who weighed 53 kilograms (118 pounds) and was severely obese, died, as per a report in Newsweek. According to a statement from the Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (SPCA), the dog, named Nuggi, was found by police in 2021 weighing about 54 kilograms (120 pounds) and nearly immobile.

Nuggi was taken from his owner's Auckland house, where police discovered "a number of" dogs, and given over to the SPCA.

Nuggi died of a liver haemorrhage even though it lost 8.8 kilograms (19.6 pounds) or around 16.5 per cent of his body weight in two months while in the care of the SPCA. The organisation claims that an autopsy disclosed additional health issues, including Cushing's illness and liver problems.

According to the statement, the owner pleaded guilty to failing to provide for the dog's medical, behavioural, and physical needs. As a result, the Manukau District Court in Auckland sentenced the owner to two months in jail



and a fine of \$1,222 NZD (\$720). It is also said that she will not be allowed to own dogs for a year.

Veterinarians using a stethoscope were unable to detect Nuggi's heartbeat because of his extreme weight, according to the SPCA statement. The dog also had a lot of skin growths, especially on contact regions like his elbows and tummy, and his claws were enlarged. Further, Nuggi had conjunctivitis as well.

Todd Westwood, SPCA Chief said that the dog was "drastically overfed" and "clearly" did not have proper care. "Nuggi was one of the most obese animals we've ever come across." Mr

Westwood said in a statement. 'Sadly, we see animals on


a daily basis that are underweight, starved or malnourished, but it's equally heartbreaking to see a helpless animal that's been severely overfed," he continued. The SPCA added that the

pet dog was fed around 10 pieces of chicken every day along with dry food. Nuggi allegedly

struggled to travel around 10 meters to the car when veterinarians took him away from his owner, pausing three times to gather breath. The SPCA said, "His legs could not support his huge body.'

"Part of being a responsible dog owner is providing your pet with an appropri-ate diet and daily exercise, which was clearly not the case here. Nuggi was being drastically overfed, and instead of seeking help or amending the behaviour, his owner continued to overfeed him until he could barely walk. This is unacceptable," Mr Westwood

SC dismisses petition seeking review of its VVPAT verdict

New Delhi: The Supreme Court has refused to review its verdict rejecting PILs demanding return to the paper ballot system or a 100% cross-verification of votes cast through EVMs with Voter Verifiable Paper Audit Trail (VVPAT) slips.

"We have carefully perused the review petition, as also the grounds in support thereof. In our opinion, no case for review of the judgment dated 26.04.2024 is made out. The review petition is, accordingly, dismissed," a Bench of Justice Sanjiv Khanna and Justice Dipankar Datta said in its July 25 order, rejecting the review petition. The Bench had on April 26 dismissed a PIL filed by Arun Kumar Agrawal seeking return to the paper ballot system or a 100% cross-verification of votes cast through EVMs with VVPAT slips even as it issued certain directions to the Election Commission to strengthen the current EVM system. Giving the thumbs up to the EVM system in the midst of the 2024 Lok Sabha elections, the Bench had said, "EVMs offer significant advantages. They have effectively eliminated booth capturing by restricting the rate of vote casting to 4 votes per minute, thereby prolonging the time needed and thus check insertion of bogus votes. EVMs have eliminated invalid votes, which were a major issue with paper ballots and had often sparked disputes during the counting process. Furthermore, EVMs reduce paper usage and alleviate logistical challenges. Finally, they provide administrative convenience by expediting the counting process and minimising errors." ..keeping in view the vast size of

EVMs didn't allow voters to verify that their votes have been accurately recorded.

"There are mistakes and errors apparent on the face of the impugned order..., and as such there are sufficient reasons which require review of the impugned order/judgment," read the review petition filed on May 10 by Agrawal, on whose PIL the top court had delivered the April 26 verdict.

The petitioner respectfully seeks review on the following issues as have been dealt with in judgment dated April 26, 2024: i) Feasibility of counting of all VVPAT paper slips in terms of time to be taken and additional manpower, ii) Vulnerability of SLU (symbol loading units) and iii) Percentage of VVPAT slips counted for tallying with EVM votes after Chandrababu Naidu...Judgment," Agrawal had submitted.

Seeking physical counting, the review petition had insisted that counting of all VVPAT slips can be done "accurately with a fraction of the employees and at a fraction of cost and within five to eight hours". However, the top

24 killed, hundreds feared trapped in Wayanad landslides. Army called in

New Delhi: At least 24 people have been killed and hundreds are feared trapped after massive landslides struck the hilly areas near Meppadi in Kerala's Wayanad district today morning amid heavy rain. Multiple agencies, including the NDRF, and the Army have been deployed for rescue operations. Mundakkai, Chooralmala, Attamala, and

Noolpuzha villages were among the worst affected areas. In a statement, the Indian Army said they have deployed 225 personnel, including medical teams. Two Air Force helicopters, a Mi-17 and an ALH (Advanced Light Helicopter), have also been put into

Prime Minister Narendra Modi spoke with Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan and assured him of all the help from the Centre to deal with the crisis.

The Prime Minister's Office has announced a compensation of Rs 2 lakh for the families of those killed in the landslides. Those injured will receive Rs 50,000.

A purported video, shared by West Coast Weatherman on X, showed the site of landslides in the district, known for its picturesque locales. Several roads have been swept away, with uprooted trees and destroyed huts dotting the landscape.

Vehicles washed away in floodwaters could



be seen stuck in tree trunks. Rescue operations were hindered due to incessant rain and some areas were unreachable due to huge boulders blocking the path of rescue workers. In a statement, Kerala Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan said, "All possible rescue operations will be coordinated on the land-slides in Wayanad."

"Since we got to know of the incident, the government systems have joined together in the rescue operation. Ministers will visit Wayanad and lead the activities," the Chief Minister said.

Meanwhile, a control room was opened in the wake of the landslides. Helpline numbers 9656938689 and 8086010833 were also

issued for emergency assistance.

In a post on X, Rahul Gandhi said he was

Rs 10 lakh to families of students

New Delhi: Delhi Lieutenant Governor V K Saxena announced financial assistance of Rs 10 lakh for the families of each of the three civil service aspirants who died after flooding in the basement of a coaching centre in Central Delhi's Old Rajinder Nagar.

Saxena, according to an official statement issued by Raj Niwas, visited the UPSC coaching hub of Old Rajinder Nagar and interacted with the students protesting over the incident. During the meeting, the LG assured prompt disciplinary action against officials of Delhi Fire Services (DFS), police, and the Municipal Corporation of Delhi (MCD) responsible for the incident within 24 hours.

He promised that nobody responsible for the deaths of the civil service aspirants would be spared.

As per the Raj Niwas statement, a joint task force of MCD and DFS, formed under the directions of the Delhi High Court following a fire incident at a coaching institute at Mukheriee Nagar earlier this year, will also conduct a survey of all the buildings in the Rajinder Nagar area.

The joint task force will seal all the basements and other illegal structures that are in violation of the building bylaws, the Master Plan Delhi (MPD) 2021, and the fire safety norms, the statement stated.

It will also undertake a similar audit in Mukherjee Nagar, Kalu Sarai, Neb

Sarai, Ber Sarai, Vijay Nagar, Outram Line, Hudson Line, Gupta Colony, and other coaching hubs of the city and seal off all illegal basements and other such structures, it added.

The Lieutenant Governor also promised to establish a regulatory mechanism to rationalise and fix rents promptly in response to protesters' complaints about exorbitant rent charges.

"The grievances of students regarding exorbitant rentals, fees, and electricity charges will be looked into by a committee. Fixation of upper limits will be undertaken as a long-term measure,' the statement reads.

He also assured me that all these actions would be completed within two

As per the statement, there will be zero tolerance for "illegal structures" of coaching or any other commercial institutions in residential areas.

"In case a building is operating completely in violation, action to demolish the building shall be taken as per the rules," it said.

Meanwhile, the Centre has constituted a high-level panel to probe into the death of the students at Rau's IAS Study circle.

Three civil service aspirants died Saturday evening after water from a flooded drain gushed into the basement of Rau's IAS Study Circle, where a library had been set up.

18 coaches of Mumbai-bound express detail after colliding with goods train. 2 dead

New Delhi: At least two passengers were killed, and six others injured after 18 coaches of the Mumbai-bound Howrah-CSMT Express derailed in Jharkhand on Tuesday following a collision with a goods train. A rescue operation is currently underway at the accident site.

The accident happened at around 3.45 am in Bara Bambu village near Chakradharpur. Ambulances and rescue teams rushed to the site soon after the derailment was notified. Om Prakash Charan, a spokesperson for the South Eastern Railways (SER), told news agency PTI that there was another derailment of a goods train nearby, but it was not yet clear whether the two accidents occurred concurrently.

"At least 18 coaches of the 22-coach 12810 Howrah-Mumbai Mail via Nagpur derailed near Barabamboo station in SER's Chakradharpur division at 3.45 AM," he said.

Of these, 16 were passenger coaches, one

power car and one pantry car, he said. "Six passengers were injured in the accident and provided medical aid in Barabamboo. They are now being taken to Chakradharpur for better treatment," another senior SER



official said. The reason for the derailment was being as-

certained, he added.

Meanwhile, three trains were cancelled, while one each was short-terminated and diverted as the route was affected after the derailment.

The cancelled trains were Howrah-Kantabanji Ispat Express (22861), Kharagpur-Dhanbad Express, and Hawrah-Barbil

South Bihar Express (13288) was diverted and Asansol Tata Memu Pass Special Train (08173) was short-terminated at Adra.

In an official statement, the Indian Railways said, "Train No. 12810 Howara-CSMT Express has derailed near Chakradharpur, between Rajkharswan West Outer and Barabamboo in Chakradharpur division."

New Delhi: A man was arrested today for allegedly killing a 20-year-old woman, whose body was found in the bushes near a railway station in Navi Mumbai's Uran. Dawood Sheikh was arrested in Karnataka's Shahpur Hill area after a two-day manhunt by Maharashtra police.

Amit Kale, DCP, Crime Branch, Navi Mumbai, said Dawood had confessed to killing Yashashree Shinde. However, the motive is yet to be ascertained. The DCP said Dawood was hiding with his relatives in Karnataka.

Police said Dawood, against whom the family of the victim had filed a POCSO case in 2019, was a resident of Bengaluru and came to Uran on July 22 to meet the woman.

The woman's family filed a complaint at the Uran police station after she went missing morning. The woman worked at a private firm in Belapur.

The woman's body was found in the



bushes near the railway station. There were multiple stab injuries on her stomach and back. The woman's face was also disfigured, but police said it might have been done by wild animals
