Mohali residents continue to grapple with waterlogging issue: Adm fails to address woes

Mohali : Despite the direction issued by Mohali DC Aashika Jain to the administration for fixing the water logging issues, the early morning rain today has once again exposed that the problem remains far from over.

On September 5, Deputy Commissioner Aashika Jain asked the Additional Deputy Commissioner (Urban Development) Damanjit Singh Mann to visit the affected areas and fix the water logging issues with the help of National Highway Authority of India officials.

Mohali, a city in Punjab that is expected to become another semiconductor hub in the country is still reeling with civil issues including inundated roads, water logging. The city residents have now started to fear monsoons as large



parts of Mohali get flooded in this season.

Many believe that Mohali which was once called the 'cousin of Chandigarh' was initially built as a planned city but the uncoordinated development over the years has increased the risk of severe future floods.

"Any development that is not carried out in consideration to water flow will amount to flooding," Harpreet Singh, a retired government official.

While the the water-logging issue is significant the lack of coordination among the departments including public health, Municipal Corporation, and GMADA has only intensified the crisis with residents being at its receiving end.

Areas including Derabassi sub-division, including Zirakpur, Lalru, and Handesra areas, and Kharar are the worst hit.

Traders to decide regarding protest tomorrow

Additional Deputy Commissioner Bhatti assured the traders that he was representing the governor and promised to arrange a meeting between the traders' representatives and the governor tomorrow, where they could discuss all their concerns in detail.

The traders' protest, organized by the Vyapari Ekta Manch, will continue until the meeting concludes tomorrow. The traders expressed their frustration, stating that they contribute billions in revenue to the government, yet the government is unwilling to accept their need-based changes or implement the MSME policy to cancel the notices.

They emphasized that the law itself provides provisions for the cancellation of such notices, and the Chandigarh Administrator holds the authority to do so.

He said that the administration has agreed to their demands and said that they will be given time to meet. Along with all this, Deepak Sharma said that till the time of meeting is found, the protes will continue.

A continent ablaze: South America surpasses record for fires

South America is being ravaged by fire from Brazil's Amazon rainforest through the world's largest wetlands to dry forests in Bolivia, breaking a previous record for the number of blazes seen in a year up to Sept. 11.

Satellite data analyzed by Brazil's space research agency Inpe has registered 346,112 fire hotspots so far this year in all 13 countries of South America, topping the earlier 2007 record of 345,322 hotspots in a data series that goes back to 1998.

Brazil and Bolivia have dispatched thousands of firefighters to attempt to control the blazes, but remain mostly at the mercy of extreme weather fueling the fires.

Scientists say that while most fires are set by humans, the recent hot and dry conditions being driven by climate change are helping the fires spread more quickly. South America has been hit by a series of heatwaves since last year.

"We never had winter," said Karla Longo, an air quality researcher at Inpe, of the weather in Sao Paulo in recent months. "It's absurd."



Despite still being winter in the Southern Hemisphere, high temperatures in Sao Paulo have held at over 32 degrees Celsius (90 degrees Fahrenheit) since Saturday. Hundreds of people marched in Bolivia's highland, political capital La Paz to demand action against the fires, holding banners and placards saying "Bolivia in flames" and "For cleaner air stop burning." "Please realize what is really happening in the country, we have lost millions of hectares,"

said Fernanda Negron, an animal rights activist in the protest. "Millions of animals have been burned to death."

In Brazil, a drought that began last year has become the worst on record, according to national disaster monitoring agency Cemaden.

"In general, the 2023-2024 drought is the most intense, long-lasting in some regions and extensive in recent history, at least in the data since 1950," said Ana Paula Cunha, a drought researcher with Cemaden.

The greatest number of fires this month is in Brazil and Bolivia, followed by Peru, Argentina and Paraguay, according to Inpe data. Unusually intense fires that

hit Venezuela, Guyana and Colombia earlier in the year contributed to the record but have largely subsided.

Fire from deforestation in the Amazon create particularly intense smoke because of the density of the vegetation burning, Longo said.

"The sensation you get flying next to one of these plumes is like that of an atomic mushroom cloud," said Longo of Inpe.

Roughly 9 million sq km (3.5 million sq miles) of South America have been covered in smoke at times, more than half of the continent, she said. Sao Paulo, the most populous city in the Western Hemisphere, earlier this week had the worst

air quality globally, higher than famous pollution hotspots like China and India, according to website IQAir.com. Bolivia's capital of La Paz was similarly blanketed in smoke.

Exposure to the smoke will drive up the number of people seeking hospital treatment for respiratory issues and may cause thousands of premature deaths, Longo said.

September is typically the peak month for fires in South America. It's unclear whether the continent will continue to have high numbers of fires this year.

While rain is forecast next week for Brazil's center south, where Sao Paulo is located, drought conditions are expected to continue through October in Brazil's northern Amazon region and center-west agricultural region.

Pb Police arrest drug inspector for facilitating illegal pharmaceuticals

Chandigarh : In a breakthrough, the Anti-Narcotics Task Force (ANTF) of Punjab Police on Friday said it has arrested a drug inspector from Mohali for facilitating smuggling operations connected to illegal pharmaceuticals, medical stores and laundering the money. The accused was in touch with drug smugglers lodged inside the jail and facilitated their network outside, a post on X quoting Director General of Police Gaurav Yadav said. Serious financial irregularities have been observed, whereby ANTF identified and froze 24 bank accounts with Rs 7.09 crore. In addition to this, two bank lockers were seized, he said. The ANTF recovered Rs 1.49 crore in cash, 260 gm of gold and foreign currency. Furthermore, substantial assets acquired through the proceeds of illegal activities were identified, including real estate valued at Rs 2.40 crore in Zirakpur and Dabwali towns. In another seizure of drugs, Border Security Force (BSF) personnel spotted two suspects fleeing on a bike near Dal village in Tam Taran.

During the chase, one suspect dropped an iPhone and Rs 200 before both managed to escape. In a follow-up action, based on a tip-off from a resident, BSF and Punjab Police conducted a joint search operation and recovered 581 grams of heroin from a house in the village, successfully foiling another cross-border drug smuggling attempt. According to the BSF, the seizure was part of ongoing efforts to make Punjab drug-free. In a step to make the state drug-free, Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann on August 28 dedicated the new office of ANTF to the people and also launched the anti-drug helpline and WhatsApp Chatbot (9779100200). He said the helpline would provide citizens and drug addicts an opportunity to be informed about the drug traffickers and ensure medical help for the addicts who intend to undergo de-addiction. CM Mann said this would help curb the drug trafficking at the grassroots and identify the big fish involved in this heinous crime, adding that the identity of the informer would be kept secret.

Police release CCTV of anti-mosque protestors pelting stones: 6 cops injured, 8 FIRs registered

Shimla : Shimla police today released the stone pelting video of protest held in Sanjauli over the alleged illegal construction of a mosque. Protest in Shimla, 8 FIRs have been registered so far. 6 policemen were injured in the protest including a woman police who had vertebrae fractures and is in a serious condition. Earlier, protestors removed the first layer of barricading and clashed with the security forces while entering the Dhali Tunnel East portal during their protest march. Police personnel used water cannons and resorted to lathi-charge to disperse protestors heading towards the Sanjauli area of Shimla. Meanwhile, Himachal Pradesh Minister Vikramaditya Singh asserted that the Himachal government will work according to the law. "There was a protest in Sanjauli, it happened on a large scale and some police personnel were also injured in it, they are in the hospital and some protestors were also injured in it," Himachal Minister Vikramaditya Singh said. He further said that the government sympathies with the protestors. "We had said earlier also that our sympathies are with them, but the law will complete its process and is doing so, the government works according to the law," the Himachal Pradesh Minister added. He further informed that members of the Mosque committee had met Municipal Commissioner Bhupender Kumar Attri and offered to demolish any illegal part of the mosque

themselves if the court orders so. "A big development has happened that the office bearers of the mosque committee met the commissioner today and they have said that to maintain communal harmony, we are ready to seal this place, for this, they have given a written letter to the Municipal Commissioner, the Municipal Commissioner will take action on it, it will be sealed, and they have also said that whatever decision comes up in the commissioner's court, they will respect that too," Vikramaditya Singh added. Earlier, Shaizad Alam, Imam, Sanjauli Mosque gave an application to the Municipal Commissioner of Shimla and said that they will demolish the alleged illegal construction of a mosque in Sanjauli to maintain harmony. "We gave this application because...all the people of Himachal Pradesh have been living in harmony for decades. We want to stay in harmony and love in the future as well. It shouldn't be given a political angle... so we gave this application that we will demolish that part ourselves...we are not doing it under any pressure, we have only pressure that is to maintain the harmony," Shaizad said. Himachal Minister Vikramaditya alleged that few people were present in the protest to incite the matter further. He also accused Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) of allowing this structure to build on that spot, saying that the three floors of this structure were built during COVID, when Jai Ram Thakur was the Chief Minister of the state.

Pb Govt dissolves 76 Panchayat Samitis after 5-year term

Chandigarh : The Punjab government has dissolved 76 out of 153 Panchayat Samitis across the state after they completed their five-year term. In Punjab, 13,000 Gram Panchayats have reportedly already been disbanded. Between September 10 and September 11, the Panchayat Samitis's terms came to an end. Subsequently, the state government designated District Development and Panchayat Officers (DDPOs) as Administrators to assume the duties of the dissolved Panchayat



Samitis in accordance with

Section 114-A of the Punjab Panchayati Raj Act. Until further notice, the designated DDPOs will oversee the operations of these Samitis. The elections for Panchayat Samitis and Zila Parishads likely to be held on November 25. Elections for Gram Panchayats are likely to be held on December 31 this year. The government has asked the Panchayati Raj Department to appoint administrators in the Panchayats.

India's Richest Woman Savitri Jindal to Contest Hry Polls as Independent Candidate

Hisar : The BJP's Kurukshetra MP Naveen Jindal's mother Savitri Jindal, who was an aspirant of a poll ticket from the party for the Haryana Assembly elections, filed her nomination from the Hisar seat as an Independent. On the last day of the filing of nominations, 74-year-old Ms Savitri, the wife of noted industrialist late O P Jindal, entered the fray against Haryana Minister and sitting MLA from Hisar Kamal Gupta. Forbes India has listed her as the richest woman in the country this year having a net worth of USD 29.1 billion. Polling for the 90 Assembly seats in Haryana will be held on October 5 and the results will be declared on October 8. After filing her nomination, she said, "I have pledged to serve Hisar for its development and



transformation. The people of Hisar are my family and Om Prakash Jindal had established my relationship with this family." "The Jindal family has always served Hisar. I am fully dedicated to living up to the expectations of the people and maintaining their trust," said Savitri Jindal. When the BJP fielded Kamal Gupta from the Hisar Assembly segment, Savitri Jindal was asked by reporters if her

contesting the seat against the ruling party would not amount to rebellion. "It won't be considered so. I had only campaigned for my son (Naveen Jindal in the Lok Sabha polls). I have not taken any membership (of the BJP)," she had said. Savitri Jindal was elected as an MLA from the Hisar seat twice. She became represented Hisar in the Haryana Assembly for the first time in 2005 as a Congress MLA. She was reelected from the seat in 2009 and was made a minister in the Singh Hooda government in 2013. She quit the Congress in March this year when her son Naveen Jindal also left the party and later joined the BJP.

NIA raids premises of relatives, aides of radical Amritpal Singh

Chandigarh : The National Investigating Team (NIA) conducted raids at the premises of relatives and aides of Member of Parliament and Sikh radical Amritpal Singh, who is lodged in Dibrugarh Jail under the National Security Act, in connection with a terrorist and gangster network. The raids were also linked to a 2023 incident in which pro-Khalistan supporters protested outside the High Commission of India in Canada's Ottawa and an attack on the Indian High Commission in London. The NIA raid was conducted at several places in Amritsar, comprising his uncle Pragat Singh Sandhu's house and workshop and his brother-in-law Amanjot Singh's residence. Amanjot is residing in Canada. Simultaneously raids were also conducted in Moga, Gurdaspur and Jalandhar districts. Charanjit Singh Bhinder, a



supporter of Amritpal, termed the raids as pressure tactics and harassing the supporters of the MP. Thirty-one-year-old radical Amritpal Singh, currently locked up in the Assam jail, won the Khadoor Sahib seat in the parliamentary polls. In April 2023, he was arrested from the village of Khalistani slain terrorist Jarnail Singh Bhindranwale after 36 days of cat-and-mouse chase across several states. He was largely unknown till September 2022 when he

returned to India from Dubai where he was running his family's transport business. After taking charge of 'Waris Punjab De' or 'the heirs of Punjab' -- floated by lawyer-actor-turned-activist Deep Sidhu in 2021, Amritpal was trying to position himself as a new fulcrum for the Panthic cause by calling on the youth to "fight for the freedom" of the Panth. Sidhu, one of the accused in the January 26, 2021, Red Fort violence case, had died in a road accident near Haryana's Sonapat in February 2022. In September of that year, Amritpal Singh's 'dastar bandi' (turban tying) ceremony was held at Rode village, marking his official installation as the head of 'Waris Punjab De'.

A mysterious signal was heard across the planet. It kept humming for nine days

New Delhi : In September 2023, scientists monitoring seismic activity around the world detected a mysterious signal. This signal, unlike any seen before, was recorded everywhere from the Arctic to Antarctica. Instead of the usual earthquake rumble, the signal was a continuous hum with only one vibration frequency, and it lasted for nine days.

At first, researchers were puzzled. They classified it as a "USO" — an unidentified seismic object.

Eventually, the source of the signal was traced to a massive landslide in Greenland's remote Dickson Fjord.

A huge amount of rock and ice, enough to fill 10,000 Olympic swimming pools, had plunged into the fjord. This caused a mega-tsunami with a wave 200 meters high, twice as tall as Big Ben in London. The landslide also triggered a seiche, a back-and-forth wave in the fjord, which continued for nine days.

The landslide's immense power was due to the thinning of the glacier, caused by global warming. In a new study, published

in the journal Science, the team added that the signal was generated by standing waves in the Dickson fjord due to the rockslide. "Our findings highlight how climate change is causing cascading, hazardous feedbacks between the cryosphere, hydrosphere, and lithosphere," the paper read.

CLIMATE CRISIS AT ITS PEAK

Over decades, the glacier lost tens of meters in thickness, weakening the mountain's support. When the mountain collapsed, it sent vibrations through the Earth, shaking the planet and generating seismic waves that were felt globally.

This event is a reminder of the growing impact of climate change.

As glaciers thin and permafrost warms, landslides and tsunamis in polar regions are likely to become more common. The landslide in Dickson Fjord highlights how climate change is not only affecting weather patterns and sea levels but also the stability of the Earth's crust.

Scientists warn that we may see more of these unexpected events as the planet continues to warm.

In a post on X, he said, "Welcome back, Arvind Kejriwal, we missed you! Truth can be troubled but not defeated! Finally, the Honourable Supreme Court has given its decision to release Delhi's son, Arvind Kejriwal, from the shackles of jail. Thanks to Honourable Supreme Court!"

Mr Kejriwal's wife Sunita Kejriwal, who made several appeals to the people of Delhi seeking support for him while he was jailed,

congratulated the AAP.

"Congratulations to AAP family! Kudos for staying strong. Wishing also the soonest release of our other leaders," she wrote in a post on X. While granting bail, the Supreme Court observed that prolonged incarceration amounts to unjust deprivation of liberty.

Mr Kejriwal was arrested by the Enforcement Directorate on March 21, 2024, in connection with a money laundering probe relating to alleged irregularities in the now-cancelled Delhi excise policy. On June 26, AAP Chief Arvind Kejriwal was arrested by CBI while he was in custody of the Enforcement Directorate in the excise case.

Crucial meeting of CPI-M to pick new general secretary

Thiruvananthapuram : For the CPI-M, it is crucial as the party will elect its new general secretary after the demise of Sitaram Yechury.

Presently from Kerala, the politburo includes Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan, M.A. Baby, A. Vijayaraghavan and M.V. Govindan. With Kerala the last

bastion of the party, which has a state government in place, it could well be an advantage and a disadvantage too, for the successor to Yechury to come from the state.

The advantage is at the moment Kerala appears to have an edge in the party with a good number in the Central Committee too.

However, the disadvantage is the Vijayan government is passing through difficult times with a series of alleged scams. Also, the national leadership of the party is not happy with the way CM Vijayan has been controlling the state unit.

Food poisoning affects over 100 including 30 children after Ganeshotsav feast

Jamnagar : Over 100 people including 30 children were hospitalised following a feast during Ganeshotsav celebrations in Elgin Society, located in the Hapa area of Jamnagar.

The affected individuals were rushed to GG Hospital for urgent medical care, causing the Trauma Ward to be overwhelmed by patients.

The incident unfolded after Elgin Society residents consumed rice and potatoes during a Ganesh Pandal feast. Soon after, attendees reported symptoms like diarrhoea and vomiting, leading to widespread panic in the community. The food included modak, rice, and other sweets.



The people who prepared the food are now being questioned. "While some have recovered, there are several who are under observation. People of all age groups are affected by this food poisoning and are now admitted to the hospital. We ran out of hospital beds due to this inflow of patients from last night to today. This season, there have been patients earlier who were also affected by similar food

poisoning," a hospital staff shared.

Sources added: "Late last night in Jamnagar, around 100 people were affected by food poisoning after consuming spiced rice served as prasad at a Ganpati pandal in the Hapa area. Following symptoms of diarrhoea and vomiting, all those affected, including children, were promptly taken to GG Hospital for treatment. The Ganesh aarti and celebration were followed by food for all society residents. We did not expect this at a Ganesh pandal. We suspect that the food was stale and contaminated. The worst part is children being admitted to hospital due to this."

FSSAI instructs States/UTs to maintain strict vigil on adulterated sweets and dairy products during festive season

Dibrugarh : The Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) has instructed all States and Union Territories to strictly monitor the manufacturing and sale of adulterated sweets, savouries and dairy products during the festive season. It also requested them to conduct frequent enforcement and surveillance drives during the festive season to prevent such malpractices.

In a letter, FSSAI noted that the demand for sweets, savories, milk, and milk products like ghee, khoya, and paneer increases during the festive season.



This heightened demand also increases the economic motivation to adulterate these

products. It emphasized that preventive measures, including special surveillance and enforcement drives at hotspots, can effectively curb these practices while ensuring product safety. The authority further suggested that to ensure these products are safe for consumption and comply with food product standards, the Food Safety on Wheels (FSW) units, where available, should be stationed in prominent markets and based on specific intelligence input.

Indian markets open at record high. Sensex above 83,000 and Nifty above 25,400

Mumbai : Indian stock markets opened at a new high today, with both indices continuing the bull run. The Nifty 50 index opened closer to its 52-week high, while the Sensex opened above the 83,000 mark for the first time.

The Nifty 50 index opened at 25,430.45, gaining 41.55 points or 0.16 percent, while the BSE Sensex opened at 83,091.55 points, a surge of 128.84 points or 0.16 percent.

Global markets are rallying ahead of the Fed rate cuts, and Indian markets are continuously reaching new highs, reflecting strong investor confidence.

"The focus is totally on the Fed action and Fed speak of Sep 18th. But the Sep 12th Indian markets action is pointing to a classical flows pattern of equity markets getting inflows as the US dollar weakens on the back of Fed rate cuts. Markets will move sharply in anticipation of this. Some minor risk off is possible early next week, in the lead up to the FOMC announcement on Sep 18th night time in India.

FII's have cut the "caution" out from our "cautious optimism" and made us ardently "optimistic" said Ajay Bagga, Banking and market expert. In the sectoral indices on the National Stock Exchange, Nifty Media led in gains, followed by Nifty Metal and Nifty PSU Bank.

In the Asian markets on Friday, there was mixed movement, with Japan's Nikkei index falling 0.89



percent, along with flat movement in South Korea's KOSPI. Meanwhile, Hong Kong's stock index surged 1.16 percent, and Taiwan's Taiwan Weighted also gained marginally, by 0.14 percent at the time of filing this report.

The U.S. markets marked the fourth consecutive session of gains, with the S&P index gaining 0.75 percent, while the Nasdaq surged 1 percent by the closing bell. The European markets also closed with positive gains after the EU announced rate cuts of 25 basis points.

Germany's DAX surged 1.02 percent, France's CAC index gained 0.51 percent, while the UK's FTSE index gained 0.57 percent. The Indian stock markets hit a record-breaking milestone on Thursday, with both Sensex and Nifty closing at record highs.

This surge was driven by broad-based buying across sectors, reflecting strong investor confidence and robust market sentiment. The Sensex skyrocketed by 1,439.55 points to close at 82,962.71, while the Nifty surged by 395.40 points, closing at 25,313.85 points.

Biden to host PM Modi, other leaders for fourth in-person Quad Leaders Summit on Sept 21

Lima : US President Joe Biden is set to host the fourth in-person Quad leaders summit in Delaware on September 21 and is looking forward to welcoming Prime Minister Narendra Modi, as well as other leaders, the White House said on Thursday (local time).

The summit will focus on bolstering strategic convergence among our countries, advancing a shared vision of free and open Indo-Pacific region. "President Joseph R. Biden, Jr. will host the fourth in-person Quad Leaders Summit in Wilmington, Delaware, today, September 21.

The President looks forward to welcoming Prime Minister Anthony Albanese of Australia, Prime Minister Narendra Modi of India, and Prime Minister Kishida Fumio of Japan," White House Press Secretary Karine Jean-Pierre said in a statement.

"This will be President Biden's first time hosting foreign leaders in



Wilmington as president--a reflection of his deep personal relationships with each of the Quad Leaders, and the importance of the Quad to all of our countries," the statement added.

It is pertinent to note that in recent years, Quad Foreign Ministers have met eight times, and Quad governments continue to meet and coordinate at all levels.

"The Biden-Harris Administration has made elevating and institutionalizing the Quad a top priority, from the

first-ever Quad Leaders Summit at the White House in 2021 to annual summits since then," Jean-Pierre said.

Quad is a diplomatic partnership between four countries--Australia, India, Japan, and the United States. "The Quad Leaders Summit will focus on bolstering the strategic convergence among our countries, advancing our shared vision of a free and open Indo-Pacific region, and delivering concrete benefits for partners in the Indo-Pacific in key areas," the statement read.

"These include health security, natural disaster response, maritime security, high-quality infrastructure, critical and emerging technology, climate and clean energy, and cybersecurity," it added. The next Quad Summit will be hosted by India.

US Presidential Polls: Trump refuses another presidential debate with Harris

Washington : The possibility of a second meeting between the two US Presidential candidates before election day was dashed when former President Donald Trump announced he would not take part in another debate with Vice President Kamala Harris.

He asserted that he won debate with Harris despite some polls showing otherwise. "When a prizefighter loses a fight, the first words out of his mouth are, 'I WANT A REMATCH'." Polls clearly show that I won the debate against Comrade Kamala Harris, the Democrats' Radical Left Candidate, on Tuesday night, and she immediately called for a Second Debate," Trump posted on Truth Social.

The former president claimed that subjects like immigration and inflation were covered "in great detail" both in Tuesday night's discussion with Harris and in his June debate with President Biden. Trump, in a strong attack on the Biden-Harris administration, said that they have "destroyed" the country. "She and Crooked Joe have



destroyed our country, with millions of criminals and mentally deranged people pouring into the USA, totally unchecked and unvetted, and with inflation bankrupting our middle class.

Everyone knows this, and all of the other problems caused by Kamala and Joe. It was discussed in great detail during the first debate with Joe, and the second debate with Comrade Harris," the former US President said.

"She was a no-show at the Fox debate and refused to do NBC & CBS," Trump said in his post, adding

"KAMALA SHOULD FOCUS ON WHAT SHE SHOULD HAVE DONE DURING THE LAST ALMOST FOUR YEAR PERIOD. THERE WILL BE NO THIRD DEBATE!" Both Donald Trump and Kamala Harris are the official presidential candidates of their respective parties, after they accepted the nomination at the conventions earlier this year.

The US presidential elections are scheduled to be held on November 5 this year. Notably, the first presidential debate was held in June between President Biden and Trump, where the former's performance expressed concerns over his age. Following this, Biden made an exit from the race and endorsed Harris. It is pertinent to note that Trump and Harris debated on Tuesday this week. It was their first meeting since Harris became the Democratic presidential nominee in late July.

'Strikes deep inside Russia ... will mean US and Europe are at war with Russia': Vladimir Putin

Moscow : Russian President Vladimir Putin said that the West would be directly involved in conflict if it permitted Ukraine to strike Russian territory using Western long-range weapons and said that it will change the very "essence and nature" of the conflict.

The Russian leader's remarks were made, a day ahead of Friday's meeting between UK Prime Minister Keir Starmer and President Joe Biden in the White House in which discussions will be on whether to let Kyiv use long-range missiles against Russia.

Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy has been pressing the Biden administration and other Western governments to authorise long-range missile strikes in Russia and pressurise Moscow to end the conflict.

On being asked about statements in the US and UK that Ukraine will be allowed to conduct strikes in Russia with long-range weapons, Putin said, "What we are seeing is an attempt to substitute notions. Because this is not a question of whether the Kiev regime is allowed or not allowed to strike targets on Russian territory. It is already carrying out strikes using unmanned aerial vehicles and other means. But using Western-made long-range precision weapons is a completely different story.

The fact is that - I have mentioned this, and any expert, both in our country and in the West, will confirm this - the Ukrainian army is not capable of using cutting-edge high-precision long-range systems supplied by the West.

They cannot do that. "These weapons are impossible to employ without intelligence data from satellites which Ukraine does not have. This can only be done using the European Union's satellites, or US satellites - in general, NATO satellites. This is the first point. The second point - perhaps the most important, the key point even - is that only NATO military personnel can assign flight missions to these missile systems. Ukrainian servicemen cannot do this. Therefore, it is not a question of allowing the Ukrainian regime to strike Russia with these weapons or not.

It is about deciding whether NATO countries become directly involved in the military conflict or not," he added. In response to a media query, Putin warned that the West will have direct involvement in the conflict if they allowed Ukraine to use long-range missiles. He asserted that Russia will make "appropriate decisions" in response to the threats posed to it. Putin said, "If this decision is made, it will



mean nothing short of direct involvement - it will mean that NATO countries, the United States, and European countries are parties to the war in Ukraine. This will mean their direct involvement in the conflict, and it will clearly change the very essence, the very nature of the conflict dramatically."

"This will mean that NATO countries - the United States and European countries - are at war with Russia. And if this is the case, then, bearing in mind the change in the essence of the conflict, we will make appropriate decisions in response to the threats that will be posed to us," he added. At a joint press conference in Poland with US Secretary of State Anthony Blinken, the Polish Foreign Minister Radoslaw Sikorski said, "Ensuring security of Ukraine, a strategic forefront of the entire North Atlantic Treaty Organization is our joint priority, and we shall continue our efforts. Poland remains a strong advocate of increasing the pressure on the Russian regime in order to force it to end the conflict against Ukraine."

"From the very beginning, we were a front runner when it comes to providing military and other kinds of assistance. As the West, we shall continue supplying Ukraine with advanced air defense and antimissile defense systems. We shall also lift the ban on using long-range weapons. We are sure that the economic sanctions are bringing the expected effect, and we hope that more intense activities will be taken with regard to seizing frozen Russian assets," he said. Blinken was in Poland after visiting Ukraine with UK foreign Secretary David Lammy.

"We went to Kyiv to underscore our united and unwavering support for Ukraine, faced with the ongoing Russian aggression - the United States, United Kingdom, but also united with so many other countries who have come together in support of Ukraine, all committed not just to helping Ukraine ward off the aggression, but committed to Ukraine's long term success, its success as a country that stands strongly on its own two feet militarily, economically, democratically."

Brazilian Aircraft Maker Embraer Eyes Suppliers From India

New Delhi : Brazil's aircraft maker Embraer is eyeing suppliers from India for its defence, commercial aviation and executive jet businesses. India is a strategic market for Embraer and has customers in commercial aviation, executive jets, and defence and security. It has 44 planes in the country.

A high level delegation from Embraer is concluding a visit to India this week as it evaluates the expansion of its supply chain into the country, according to a release.

Embraer said it foresees potential suppliers across its defence, commercial aviation and executive



jets businesses for areas such as aerostructures, machining, sheet metal, composites, forgings, wire harness, and hardware and software development.

"India has a robust aviation and

defense industry, and we see strong viability for manufacturers and systems developers in India to be key suppliers to Embraer," Roberto Chaves, Executive Vice-President of Global Procurement and Supply Chain at Embraer, said.

The company along with Mahindra expects to implement an extensive local supply chain programme.

"This initiative may include an assembly line for the C-390 in India, when selected for this programme," the release said.

Bomb threat rattles US city in Republican anti-migrant conspiracy

Springfield : Government buildings and an elementary school in Springfield, Ohio were evacuated Thursday after an emailed bomb threat, police said, rattling the small US city at the heart of an anti-migrant conspiracy theory amplified by Donald Trump.

Springfield has been thrust into the spotlight in recent days after an unfounded story of Haitian migrants eating pets went viral on social media, with the Republican ex-president and current White House candidate pushing the narrative despite it being debunked.

Democrats have accused Trump and his running mate, Ohio Senator JD Vance, of fanning racial tensions as they use the Springfield conspiracy



theory to elevate immigration as a campaign issue ahead of November's election.

Trump doubled down on the rhetoric during a campaign rally in Tucson, Arizona on Thursday, saying that "migrants are walking off" with the town's geese."

Immediately after mentioning Springfield in his speech, Trump added: "I'm angry about young

American girls being raped and sodomized and murdered by savage criminal aliens," though provided no specific details.

Springfield authorities said there were no credible reports of pets being harmed by members of the immigrant community -- accusations that Trump also repeated in his

Thursday debate against Democratic Vice President Kamala Harris.

The White House condemned the claims as "filth" and said they were endangering people's lives.

Springfield police said that City Hall and several other government buildings had been evacuated after a bomb threat sent by email at 8:24 am (1224 GMT).

Congress Leader Jagdish Tytler Pleads 'Not Guilty' In 1984 Sikh Riots Case

New Delhi : Congress leader Jagdish Tytler today pleaded not guilty to charges - including murder and provocation with intent to cause riot - relating to the killing of three men outside Delhi's Pul Bangash gurdwara during the anti-Sikh riots of 1984. "Today, Jagdish Tytler pleaded 'not guilty' to the charges. Now the case will go for evidence... the court has fixed October 3 (for the trial)," Advocate HS Phoolka told reporters, lamenting the four-decade delay. "It has taken 40 years for this trial to begin. It is very unfortunate and shows how a powerful person can cripple the whole system. Hopefully, the trial will conclude soon and he will be jailed."

A Delhi court, two weeks ago, had ordered framing of the charges, ruling enough evidence had been provided by the Central Bureau of Investigation for the case to proceed to a trial.

Apart from murder and intent to cause a riot, Tytler faces charges of unlawful assembly, rioting, disobedience to order, defiling a place of worship, abetment, mischief by fire, and theft. The CBI, in a chargesheet filed in May last year, had accused Tytler, a former Union Minister, of "inciting, instigating and provoking the mob" assembled near the gurdwara in November 1984.

CBI's Eyewitness Statements
In concluding arguments in January, the federal agency presented eyewitnesses' statements and told the court there is sufficient evidence to frame charges against the Congress leader.

"Tytler provoked the mob to kill Sikhs which resulted in Gurudwara Pul Bangash being set on fire by the mob and killing of three persons..." the CBI had said.

One witness claimed to have seen a mob carrying petrol canisters, sticks, swords, and rods, with Tytler, then a Member of Parliament, in front of the gurdwara, while others claimed to have seen him emerge from a car - a white Ambassador - and exhort the gathered mob to carry out his "instructions".

Tytler Defends Himself
Tytler, however, has insisted there is not a 'single (piece of) evidence'.

"What have I done? If there is evidence against me I'm prepared to hang myself... It wasn't related to 1984 riots case for which they (the CBI) wanted my voice sample..." he had said in August last year.



In May 2022 Tytler had said, "I will apologise because it (the riots) happened in our time. I would apologise a thousand times for what happened to the Sikhs... I would say it was shameful."

The assassination of then Prime Minister Indira Gandhi, by her Sikh bodyguards, in 1984 after her controversial Operation Blue Star, led to violent riots. Tytler got a clean chit from the CBI on three previous occasions, but after the last the court directed the agency to investigate further.

Congress, Manmohan Singh's Apology

Jagdish Tytler has long been a point of attack for the Congress' rivals, including, in the past, current allies Aam Aadmi Party. The party has been accused of shielding its accused leaders.

In 2012 Congress veteran Dr Manmohan Singh, then the Prime Minister, had apologised to Members of Parliament and the country for the riots that killed thousands. "I have no hesitation in apologising to not only the Sikhs... but also the nation. I bow my head in shame that such a thing happened," he had said.

Subsequently the party's senior leaders, Sonia Gandhi and Rahul Gandhi also apologised and expressed regret; Mr Gandhi had said, "Prime Minister of UPA (the Congress-led ruling alliance) has apologised and President of the party (Ms Gandhi) expressed regrets. I share their sentiments..."

Tytler, 80, once a key Congress leader in Delhi, was also named in a report by the Nanavati Commission. His case was one of the three the panel recommended, in 2005, be reopened by the CBI.

Tytler is out on bail granted by a sessions court on a bond and surety of ₹ 1 lakh each. That court had also imposed certain conditions on him, including guarantees that he will not tamper with the evidence or leave the country without permission.

CM Kejriwal cannot make comments about the case in public: SC

New Delhi : In a major relief to Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal, the Supreme Court on Friday granted him bail in the corruption case linked to the alleged liquor policy scam, but set some conditions.

However, Justice Surya Kant, heading a two-judge bench, dismissed his 'distinct plea challenging the legality of arrest by the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) in the alleged liquor scam and the subsequent demand.

Justice Kant held that there exists "no merit" in the contention that the CBI failed to adhere to the procedural law governing arrest and that Kejriwal's arrest did not suffer from any procedural infirmities.

"We have pointed out that (CBI's) FIR was registered in August 2022 and four supplementary charge sheets have been filed. Additionally,



17 accused persons have been named, over 200 individuals have been identified as witnesses and extensive documents, both physical and digital, have been submitted. These factors suggest that completion of the trial is unlikely to occur in the immediate future," said Justice Kant, adding that "prolonged incarceration of an accused person pending trial amounts to an unjust deprivation of personal liberty."

"The appellant is directed to be released on bail in connection with the CBI's FIR, subject to furnishing bail bonds of Rs 10 lakh with two sureties of such like amount to the satisfaction of the trial court," the top court ordered. Further, it asked CM Kejriwal "to not make any public comments" in relation to the pending CBI case.

"The terms and conditions imposed by the coordinate bench in ED matter shall apply in this case also. The appellant (Kejriwal) shall remain present before the trial court on each and every date of the hearing unless granted an exemption. He shall fully cooperate with the trial court for expeditious completion of trial proceedings," directed Justice Kant-led Bench.

SC grants bail to CM Kejrival in Delhi Excise case

New Delhi : The Supreme Court today granted bail to Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal in the corruption case linked to the alleged liquor policy scam.

In a crucial judgment pronounced, the Supreme Court said "conditions to be fixed by the trial court".

Two concurring judgments by two justices were pronounced.

In his opinion, Justice Surya Kant granted bail to Delhi CM Arvind Kejriwal in the case. The other judge, Justice Ujjal Bhuyan, authored a separate opinion raising serious questions on the timings of arrest by the CBI and held the "belated arrest" by the central agency to be unjustified.

Last week, the Bench of Justices Kant and Bhuyan, reserved its decision after hearing the oral arguments advanced by senior advocate Abhishek Mann Singhvi, representing the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) supremo, and Additional Solicitor General (ASG) S.V. Raju, who appeared on behalf of the CBI. During the hearing, Singhvi contended that the CBI did not arrest CM Kejriwal for two years but made an "insurance arrest in a hurry" to prevent his release in the money laundering case. The CBI arrested Kejriwal for "his non-cooperation and evasive replies" but there were several apex court judgments that held that cooperation with the probe should not mean that the accused should incriminate himself and confess to the offences alleged, he said.

Singhvi added that CM Kejriwal, a constitutional functionary holding the position of Delhi Chief Minister, satisfied the triple test for grant of bail. "He is not a flight risk, he will turn up to answer the questions of the investigative agency, and cannot tamper with documents, running into lakhs of pages, and digital evidence after two years," he submitted. On



former Delhi Deputy Chief Minister Manish Sisodia, BRS leader K. Kavitha, and AAP's former communication-in-charge Vijay Nair in the excise policy case.

In his special leave petition filed before the Supreme Court, the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) convener challenged his arrest and subsequent remand orders while also pressing for bail in the corruption case. On the other hand, seeking dismissal of CM Kejriwal's plea, the CBI said that the AAP supremo was simply attempting to politically sensationalise the matter,

despite repeated orders passed by various courts being prima facie satisfied with the commission of the offences, for which cognisance already has been taken.

The agency said that while CM Kejriwal "does not hold any ministerial portfolio in Government National Capital Territory (GNCT) of Delhi, all decisions of the government, as well as the party, are taken on his concurrence and directions", adding that these include not only the decisions in Delhi but also throughout the country where AAP has a presence.

The Supreme Court, on July 12, ordered CM Kejriwal to be released on interim bail in connection with the money laundering case lodged by the Enforcement Directorate (ED). However, he was not able to walk out of jail since he was arrested by the CBI. A Delhi court extended till September 25 the judicial custody of CM Kejriwal, who was produced through video conferencing from Tihar Jail upon expiry of previously granted judicial custody.

Gym owner shot dead

New Delhi : In a shocking incident, a 35-year-old gym owner was shot dead in Delhi's Greater Kailash-I, police said.

After getting information about the crime at 10.45 p.m., PCR, local police, crime team, Forensic Science Laboratory (FSL) team and Deputy Commissioner of Police (South) Ankit Chauhan rushed to the spot.

The deceased was identified as Nadir Ahmed Shah who used to run the gym in partnership.

The cause of the crime is yet to be ascertained.

The gym owner, who suffered five bullet wounds, was rushed to Max Hospital where he was declared brought dead.

Resident Welfare Association President Rajendra Sharda said that two assailants riding on a scooter opened indiscriminate firing on Shah



when he was returning home after closing the gym for the day. The accused had fired over a dozen rounds at the victim. Shah, an Afghan-origin man who lived in CR Park, opened the gym nearly six months ago, Sharda said. Police have formed five teams to probe the murder and are reviewing the CCTV footage.

According to DCP Ankit Chauhan, the case will be solved soon with the help of technical surveillance and CCTV footage.

Sources said Shah was a police informer and knew senior officials in the Delhi Police.

As per some unverified social media posts, Rohit Godara, a close accomplice of Goldy Brar of the Lawrence Bishnoi gang, has taken responsibility for the crime.

Godara said he ordered the killing of Shah after his aide Samir Baba, who is jailed at Tihar, texted him that Shah was obstructing their business deals.

"If anyone else should dare to do the same, they will meet the same fate," the post read.
