Row over Delhi Waqf Board report, 'null & void'-CM Atishi

New Delhi : Delhi Chief Minister Atishi today wrote a letter to Joint Parliamentary Committee (JPC) chairman BJP MP Jagdambika Pal, saying that the report submitted by Delhi Waqf Board must be treated as "null and void". The Chief Minister said that the report was submitted without getting the Delhi government's

This report has been submitted by IAS Ashwini Kumar (administrator of the Delhi Waqf Board) without the approval of the government of the NCT of Delhi and therefore may be treated as ab initio null and void. Any presentation on the same may be cancelled till a report is submitted with the approval of the Government of NCT of Delhi," the

Protesting over the Delhi Waqf Board's report, several opposition leaders walked out of the JPC meeting today. Reiterating Chief Minister Atishi's remark, the opposition leaders claimed that the Delhi Waqf Board administrator made changes to the presentation without the knowledge of the Delhi government, news agency PTI reported

AAP member Sanjay Singh, the DMK's Mohammed Abdulla, the Congress's Naseer Hussain, and Mohamed Jawed,



among others, walked meeting.

claimed that the Commissioner and the Delhi Waqf Board administrator have completely changed the initial report without taking the Chief Minister's nod.

It was immediately sent to a joint parliamentary committee opposition parties and Muslim organisations expressed concerns, claiming that the bill was a targeted measure against the community and an infringement on its constitutional

The JPC had in August invited views and suggestions from the public, NGOs, experts, stakeholders, and institutions on the law that the NDA government had proposed to change the Waqf law. It gave a 15-day window for people to send in their feedback.

Pappu Yadav qets Lawrence Bishnoi threat after 'main hoon na' post for Salman Khan

Patna: Bihar MP Pappu Yadav has received a death threat allegedly from the Lawrence Bishnoi gang. In an audio clip, the caller claimed that he was closely monitoring Yadav's movements, and threatened to kill him if he didn't stay away from matters involving actor Salman Khan. The caller also claimed that Lawrence Bishnoi - who is in Sabarmati jail in Ahmedabad - was paying Rs 1 lakh per hour to disable signal jammers, allowing him to establish direct communication with Yadav, who he said had been ignoring their calls.

Recently, the Lawrence Bishnoi gang claimed the murder of NCP leader Baba Siddique in Mumbai. After the politician's murder, Pappu Yadav, the Independent MP from Purnea, openly challenged Bishnoi, declaring that he would dismantle the network of "a two-bit criminal" like the gangster within 24 hours if allowed.

In a recorded audio message, the caller can be heard saying, "You could have told 'bhai' that the media did this, not me. Settle the matter as soon as possible. I considered you an elder brother, and you've embarrassed me. Call back, and I'll connect you

with 'bhai.'"

Yadav reported the threat to Bihar's Director General of Police (DGP), urging immediate action.

Condemning Baba Siddique's murder, Yadav labelled it a disgrace, stating on X that the killing of a government-backed former minister highlighted "total lawlessness" in Maharashtra. He further remarked, 'The murder of Bihar's son, Baba Siddique, is extremely tragic. If the BJP-led government cannot protect its influential leaders, what hope is there for ordinary people?"

During a press conference that followed, Yadav grew visibly frustrated when journalists asked about Lawrence Bishnoi, reminding them, "I've already told you not to ask irrelevant questions here." A video of him losing his temper during the exchange has since gone viral.

ED attaches assets worth Rs 503 crore in businessman's bank fraud case

New Dehli: The Enforcement Directorate (ED) has attached assets worth Rs 503.16 crore belonging to Nagpur-based businessman Manoj Jayaswal, his power company, Corporate Power Limited, and its other promoters in a high-profile bank fraud case.

The assets--comprising properties, buildings, bank balances, mutual funds, and shares--were recovered from various locations across Maharashtra, West Bengal, Bihar, Jharkhand, and Andhra Pradesh as part of the probe into Corporate Power Limited and its directors: Manoj Jayaswal, Abhijeet Jayaswal, Abhishek Jayaswal, and others.

According to the ED, these properties and buildings were acquired under the names of multiple shell tcompanies, as well as in the names of Manoj Jayaswal, his company, and family members. The ED investigation stems from a CBI FIR filed against Corporate Power Limited and its owners on charges of criminal conspiracy, cheating, and forgery, following a



complaint by Union Bank of India. It is alleged that the accused submitted manipulated project cost statements to obtain loans and misappropriated bank funds, causing a wrongful loss estimated at Rs 4,037 crore (Rs 11,379 crore including interest).

Earlier in this case, the ED conducted searches in Nagpur, Kolkata, and Visakhapatnam, seizing various documents and freezing proceeds of crime-totalling Rs 223.33 crore in listed shares and securities, mutual funds, fixed deposits, and bank balances. Cash amounting to Rs 55.85 lakh was also seized.

Bishnoi Gang's Rival Fires at Delhi Businessman's House, Leaves a Note

New Delhi: Two men affiliated with the Bambiha Gang, the rival of the incarcerated gangster Lawrence Bishnoi, opened fire at the residence of a businessman in Delhi, police said today. The shooting occurred in North West Delhi's Rani Bagh around

8.40 am on Saturday and the two accused, who were on a bike, threw a chit on which 'Bambiha Gang' was written.

At least six to seven rounds were fired outside the house, officials said. However, no call has so far been received regarding extortion.

Delhi has witnessed an increase in firing incidents as part of extortion attempts recently.

Last month, three sensational incidents of firing occurred in the capital -- at a car showroom in Naraina in west Delhi, a hotel in southwest Delhi and the sweet shop, all were linked to extortion activities by gangsters.



In the first incident, shots were fired at a second-hand car showroom called 'Car Street Mini' in southwest Delhi's Naraina, barely a kilometre from the Naraina police station. Officials said at least 20 rounds were fired by three men who entered the showroom, causing panic in the area.

The shooters left behind a slip, reading "Bhau Gang, Since 2020". The "Bhau Gang" mention was seen as a reference to wanted gangster Himanshu Bhau, who fled the country in 2022 and is currently believed to be in Portugal. He had also claimed responsibility for the murder of a man at a food outlet in Delhi.

This landmark event marks the commencement of the final assembly line for the Airbus C295 aircraft, set to significantly enhance India's aerospace capabilities and defense landscape.

Due to the lackadaisical approach of the civic body, people can be seen openly flouting norms and dumping waste on the roadsides.

Main roads in Phase 4, Phase 5, and other surroundings of Mohali city face the same, Industrial Area Phase 7 is heavily

affected by littering issue.
Residents said that the MC and GMADA officials have failed to take any actions over the persisting problem, and Residents expressed ignorance about who dumps garbage on the road, however, it is

an open secret that there are no dustbins in the area and there is no designated place to collect and dispose of garbage i the city

only feel responsibility fo cleaning their homes which they ignor broader civil sense. They feel justified in dumping waste or littering the roads. The civic authorities should impose heavy penalties and install CCTV cameras who catch such defaulters," stated residents.

"People can't be solely blamed for the state of cleanliness in the city. There are no dustbins, lack of proper dumping areas has left people with no option but to dump waste on city roads," expressed anothe



Former MC RP Sharma said Residents are expressing their frustration over the increasing amounts of litter and garbage piling up on the city's roads. Complaints have surged as areas once known for their cleanliness now bear the brunt of neglect, with trash scattered across streets and public spaces.



Paramjit Singh Kahlon Former MC reported that the garbage collection services have been inconsistent, leading to overflowing bins and littered sidewalks. "It's become unbearable. The smell is awful, and it attracts pests," and added that this unsightly situation not only affects the aesthetics of the city but also poses health risks and urged the municipal authorities to take immediate action and ensure proper cleanliness in Mohali. .

Chandigarh: The Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) Punjab attacks Congress and BJP for their leaders paddling drugs in Punjab and putting the lives and futures of our youth in danger. AAP said that with the arrest of a Congress leader in Baba Bakala with more than 100 kgs of Heroin (worth 500 crores) prove how deeply these parties and their leaders are involved in the nexus that has ruined Punjab. AAP Minister Tarunpreet Singh Sondh held a press conference today, accompanied by Amandeep Singh, Chairman of Markfed, to address the serious issue of drug trafficking in Punjab and the involvement of Congress and BJP leaders.

Minister Sondh revealed connections between these political parties and the ongoing drug crisis in the state. He highlighted the recent



arrest of Navjot Singh, a Congress circle chief from Baba Bakala, who was apprehended by Punjab Police during a counter-intelligence operation. Authorities seized a staggering 105 kilograms of heroin, along with 31 kilograms of caffeine, five foreign pistols, and a countrymade gun from his possession. The estimated value of the heroin is

around ₹500 crores.

'I commend the Punjab Police for their exceptional efforts in intercepting this significant drug shipment, which was traced from Pakistan through Jammu," said Minister Sondh. 'This operation demonstrates (AAP government's) commitment to combating drug-related crimes."

A few days ago in another alarming case, the Anti-Narcotics Task Force (ANTF)

arrested former MLA Satkar Kaur. This further led to the capture of her nephew, Jaskirat Singh, along with the recovery of 100 grams of heroin from their vehicle. A subsequent search of their home uncovered an additional 28 grams of heroin and ₹156,000 in cash, as well as several luxury vehicles registered in Haryana and Delhi.

Head Cashier of PSPCL caught by Vigilance Bureau for taking Rs 50,000 bribe

Chandigarh : The Punjab Vigilance Bureau (VB), during its ongoing campaign against corruption in the state, today apprehended Head Cashier Davinder Singh, posted at Punjab State Power Corporation Ltd (PSPCL) office, Sub Division South, Amritsar for demanding and accepting a bribe of Rs. 50,000. Disclosing this here today an official spokesperson of the state VB said the above-mentioned accused has been arrested on a complaint lodged by Narinder Kumar, a resident of Bazar Gujran, Bhagtan Wala, Gate Hakima, Amritsar.



He further informed that the complainant has approached the VB and alleged in his complaint that he had given an application for the installation of a commercial electrical meter at his shop at Shakti Nagar, Amritsar and the accused had demanded a bribe of Rs 1,00,000 for clearing the paper

The spokesperson added that after a preliminary enquiry into this complaint a VB team laid a trap during which the aforementioned accused was caught red-handed while accepting a bribe of Rs. 50,000 from the complainant in the presence of two official witnesses

He added that in this regard a case under the Prevention of Corruption Act has been registered at VB Police Station, Amritsar range. The accused would be produced in the competent court tomorrow and further investigations into this case was under progress, he said

IAS Vipin Kumar takes over as Chairman AAI

New Delhi: Vipin Kumar, an IAS officer of 1996 batch, Bihar cadre took over as Chairman of Airports Authority of India, today.

to this appointment, Kumar was serving as Additional Secretary, Department of School Education & Literacy, Ministry Education, Government of India. During his tenure at Ministry of Education, Government of India, he was looking after SamagraShiksha Scheme, National Education Policy-2020, Scheme and other important assignments. During his posting in Bihar, he worked as District Magistrate in many districts of the state. He was also the Chairman of Bihar Bridge Construction Corporation; Managing Director of Bihar Milk Cooperative Federation (SUDHA) and Director, Mid-Day Scheme-Bihar. Vipin Kumar holds a degree in Electronics & Communication Engineering. In his new assignment as the Chairman of the Airports Authority of India, Kumar will lead efforts to achieve AAI's organizational goals of developingworld-class airport infrastructure, leading air navigation



services and providing top-of-the-line passenger facilities across the country.

His role will be instrumental in charting the roadmap of Indian Aviation Sector towards realizing the Hon'ble Prime Minister's vision of Viksit Bharat-2047. Airports Authority of India (AAI) was constituted by an Act of Parliament and came into being on 1st April 1995 by merging erstwhile National Airports Authority and the International Airports Authority of India.

The merger brought into existence a single Organization entrusted with the responsibility of creating, upgrading,

maintaining and managing civil aviation infrastructure both the ground and air space in the country.AAI manages a total of 133 airports out of which 110 airports are operational while other 23 airports are non-operational. These operational airports include 28 civil enclaves and 8 airports under private control [2] JV Airports + 6 PPP Airports under long term lease]. 35 out of total 110 AAI operational airports have

international operations. AAI provides air navigation services over 2.8 million square nautical miles of air space.
During the year 2023-24, AAI at its

airports (excluding JV and PPP Airports) handled aircraft movement of 1053.96 Thousand [International 103.75 & Domestic 950.21], Passengers handled 130.67 Million [International 15.09 & Domestic 115.58] and the Freight handled thousand MT [International & Domestic 349.53].

India concludes U23 World Wrestling Championships with 9 medals

The Indian Tirana : wrestling team concluded the U23 World Wrestling Championships 2024 with a commendable tally of nine medals, comprising one gold, one silver, and seven bronze medals.

The event took place from October 21 to 27 in Tirana, Albania. Chirag achieved the sole gold medal for India in the men's 57 kg category, marking him as only the third Indian wreather to attain this Indian wrestler to attain this honor at the championships, following Olympic medalist Aman Sehrawat (men's 57 kg) in 2022 and Reetika Hooda (women's 76 kg) in the previous year, according to Olympics.com.

It is important to note that Reetika competed under the United World Wrestling (UWW) banner during last year's championships due to sanctions imposed on the Wrestling Federation of India (WFI) amid protests by wrestlers.

Additionally, Ravi Kumar Dahiya, a medalist from the Tokyo 2020 Olympics, secured a silver medal in the men's 57 kg division in 2018. Anji, competing in the women's 59 kg category, achieved a silver medal for India. Monika, who earned a bronze medal in the women's 65 kg division

last year, continued her impressive performance in the tournament by securing her second consecutive bronze, this time in the 68 kg category.

Sujeet, a former bronze medalist at the U20 World Championships participant in the Paris 2024 Olympic qualifiers, also claimed the bronze medal in the men's 70 kg freestyle

earned a bronze Vicky medal in the men's 97 kg category, marking him as the first Indian to achieve a medal in the heavyweight division at the U23 World Championships.

The competitions featured ten weight categories for both men's and women's freestyle and Greco-Roman

wrestling.
A total of 664 wrestlers participated, with India entering one competitor per category, comprising 240 in men's freestyle and Greco-Roman, and 184 in women's freestyle, all competing in Albania.

The Indian wrestling team had a successful outing, securing nine medals in total, which included one gold, two silver, and six bronze from the previous year's U23 World Championships.



The Tata Aircaft Complex is responsible for manufacturing these 40 aircraft in India. This facility will be the first private sector Final Assembly Line (FAL) for military aircraft in India.

Delhi air pollution persists in 'Very Poor' category, thick smoq engulfs

New Delhi : The Central Board of Direct Taxes (CBDT) has extended the deadline for corporate taxpayers to file income tax returns for the Assessment Year (AY) 2024-25. Originally set for October 31, the deadline is now November 15, 2024, as announced by the Ministry of Finance.

The extension applies to taxpayers covered under sub-Section (1) of Section 139 of the Income-tax Act, 1961. This follows a recent extension of the tax audit report submission deadline, moved from September 30 to October 7, 2024.

Under income tax law, certain taxpayers are required to conduct an income tax audit, with the report



traditionally due by September 30 of the assessment year.

However, Nangia Andersen LLP Tax Partner Sandeep Jhunjhunwala told news agency PTI that the extended filing date does not affect the Tax Audit Report, transfer pricing certification in Form 3CEB, or other tax forms like Form 10DA, which remain due by

October 31, 2024. Rajat Mohan, Senior Partner at

AMRG & Associates, highlighted that the CBDT's decision to extend the filing deadline, while not officially explained, aligns with the upcoming festive season.

By extending the deadline to November 15, 2024, taxpayers and professionals alike can prioritise accuracy and compliance without the stress of last-minute filings amidst

celebrations," said.
Jhunjhunwala added, "This targeted extension seeks to facilitate compliance during a peak period while upholding the timely submission of critical audit documentation."

Goa: The prime accused in the online trading scam case, Deepankar Barman, was arrested by the Assam Police from Goa, DGP GP Singh said. The arrest came after an intense cross-country search for two months.
The multi-crore online trading scam in

the state came to light in August when investors, who had put in huge amounts of money in 29-year-old Barman's company, complained that they were not paid due returns. They also complained that Deepankar Barman's office had been

Guwahati's Police Commissioner Diganta Barah said a team led by ACP Amit Mahato made the arrest.

"Finally, Dipankar Burman arrested at

The accused will likely be produced before a court in Goa today and brought to Guwahati on transit remand, said another police officer.

While over 65 people, including those allegedly running similar scams, were arrested, Barman was at large.

Barman's parents, Chabin Barman and Deepali Talukdar, along with Mukesh Agarwal, a chartered accountant and



financial planner for the consultancy, were arrested by police last month.
Assamese actor Sumi Borah and her

photographer husband Tarkik Borah were among those arrested in the scam.

The state government had handed over

the investigation in 41 cases registered in connection with the scam to the CBI. Several firms, promoted mostly by men

and women in their 20s, allegedly raised hundreds of crores of rupees from people across the state with the promise that they would get huge returns by investing in the stock markets.

As these firms failed to repay their investors, the scam came to light.

Washington: A scion of the famed Kennedy family. A Green Party activist. A self-proclaimed "armed and gay" libertarian.

The US presidential election is toss-up

The OS presidential election is toss-up between Democrat Kamala Harris and Republican Donald Trump.

However, the two-party system still left room this year for three fringe players who could yet influence an ultra-tight election on November 5.

Leftists Jill Stein, Cornel West

Jill Stein, 74, ran for president as the Green Party candidate in 2012 and then in 2016, winning just 0.4 percent and one

This time, the Chicago-born physician and environmental activist will be on the ballot in nearly 40 states, presenting a headache for the Democrats as she could peel off a crucial handful of votes from Harris in contests where she is neck and neck against Trump.

Last week, the Democratic National

Committee released a television ad against Stein in the battleground states of Michigan, Pennsylvania and Wisconsin,



which says that "a vote for Stein is really a

Stein has sought to distance herself from President Joe Biden's administration and vowed to stop supporting what she called Israel's "genocide" in Gaza.
She has advocated for raising taxes for the

richest Americans, canceling student debt and reducing defense spending. Cornel West, another candidate from the

green camp, chose to run independently of the Green Party.
The 71-year-old academic and anti-racism

activist who calls Biden a "war criminal" and describes Trump as a "neofascist" will

be on the ballot in nearly a dozen states. He too will siphon a tiny, but potentially painful number of votes from Harris.

Chase Oliver, Libertarian

The Libertarian Party received a little over one percent of the vote in 2020 and this year will be on the ballot in almost all 50 states, also acting as a potential spoiler.

The new face of the party, which advocates for free trade and limited government, is Chase Oliver, a 39-yearold former Democrat, who ran for a Senate seat from Georgia in 2022.

Unknown at the time, the science fiction fan who describes himself as "armed and gay" got around two percent of the vote, forcing a runoff between the incumbent Democrat and his Republican challenger. Oliver favors pro-gun, fiscally conservative policies, but also supports abortion rights, the legalization of cannabis and is against the death penalty. Oliver who will be on the ballot in three battleground states.

Thousands of kindergartens closed as birth rate declines sharply

: Thousands kindergartens across China have closed as enrollment rates dropped sharply, driven by a significant decline in birth rates.

According to the Chinese Ministry of Education's annual report, the number of kindergartens in China decreased by 14,808 in 2023, bringing the total to 274,400. This marks the second consecutive year of decline, underscoring China's falling birth rates.

Kindergarten enrollment also fell for the third year in a row, dropping by 11.55 percent, or 5.35 million children, to a total of 40.9 million, the Hong Kong-based sources reported citing the ministry's report. Primary schools have experienced a similar trend, with numbers dropping by 5,645 to 143,500—a 3.8 percent decline in 2023. These decreases reflect broader demographic shifts in China, where declining birth rates and a shrinking population could pose risks to future economic growtĥ.

China's population decreased for the second consecutive year in 2023, falling by over two million to 1.4 billion. The country recorded just nine million births, its lowest number since record-keeping began in 1949. India recently overtook China as the world's most populous country.

China now faces a dual crisis: not only are birth and fertility rates declining, but the elderly population

is also rising rapidly. By the end of 2023, nearly 300 million people were aged 60 and above, a number projected to surpass 400 million by 2035 and reach 500 million by 2050, A growing number of kindergartens.

have been repurposed as care centers for senior citizens. The surge in the elderly population, largely influenced by the now-defunct onechild policy, has led to increased reliance on social security, adding pressure to government finances amid a slowing economy.

attribute Officials demographic crisis to the decadesold one-child policy, which ended in 2016. In 2021, the government revised the policy again, allowing up to three children per family to address couples' reluctance to have more children due to high costs.

In response to rising pension and elderly care expenses, China raised the retirement age last month, increasing it from 60 to 63 for men and from 55 to 58 for female office workers.

According to National Health Commission data from 2021, over 30 percent of families with infants and toddlers need childcare services, but only 5.5 percent have access to

nurseries or pre-kindergartens. In the face of a shrinking and aging population, China is aiming to simplify marriage procedures while making divorce more challenging.

Immigration. Abortion among 5 Issues at Stake

Washington: Tax breaks for families with children? Supporting Ukraine? Drilling for oil?

From taxes, to immigration, to abortion -- here are the five key issues which are at stake as Donald Trump and Kamala Harris enter a final sprint in the race for the White House.

Trump, who cut taxes for businesses and the wealthy during his 2017-2021 presidency, plans to impose tariffs of more than 10 percent on all US imports, which he says will enable him to lower taxes for Americans.

The Republican has also vowed to make the United States the "crypto capital of the planet," and launched his own cryptocurrency platform with his sons in September.

Democrat Harris, meanwhile, is appealing to the middle class with her promise to create an "opportunity economy," while pitching moderate tax hikes for the richest

The 60-year-old has also promoted child tax credits, support for first-



time homebuyers, and help for small businesses Immigration

Trump has taken a hard-line approach on immigration, saying that he will order mass deportations of millions of undocumented migrants if reelected. The former president, who in 2016 promised to build a wall along the US-

Mexico border, has accused immigrants of "poisoning the blood of our country." For her part, Harris has pledged a tough stance and warned of "consequences" for people who enter the country illegally. She has supported President Joe Biden's

plan to tighten up immigration policy, notably by investing in physical barriers on the border.

Reproductive rights are a big issue for some US voters after the federal right to abortion was removed in 2022 with the overturning of Roe v Wade, resulting in total abortion bans in some states.

Trump has often boasted of his role in appointing the Supreme Court justices who scrapped the 1973 decision, and has further hinted that he may restrict access to drugs used in medical abortions if reelected.

The 78-year-old, who was found liable last year for sexually assaulting writer E. Jean Carroll, has nonetheless promised to be "great for women."

Harris wants to pass a federal law to reinstate nationwide abortion rights, making the issue a key part of her presidential campaign.
On November 5, voters in 10 states will

decide whether to adopt constitutional amendments that could shape the future of abortion access in their states.

Zionist regime made a mistake, Khamenei's X account suspended

Supreme Leader Ali Khamenei's Hebrew language account on the social media platform X was suspended a day after it was opened amid the escalating tensions between Israel and Iran.

The account was suspended hours after he threatened to retaliate for the recent Israeli strike on Iran, saying, "The Zionist regime made a mistake. It erred in its calculations on Iran. We will cause it to understand what kind of strength, ability, initiative, and will the Iranian nation has".

Khamenei opened the account to post in Hebrew, a language spoken in Israel, after Israel launched air strikes on military targets in Iran. The @Khamenei_Heb account currently shows it has been suspended for violating X's rules.

Khamenei's main account on X, where he primarily posts in English and often in Hebrew, is live on the platform. He also has a separate account for posts in Arabic. Additionally, another twitter



handle 'Khamenei Media' also posts his words, which are often retweeted by his main account.

Israel conducted airstrikes targeting military sites in Tehran and surrounding areas, resulting in the deaths of four Iranian soldiers. This action was a response to Iran's recent barrage of rockets fired into Israel earlier this month. Initially, Iranian authorities attempted to play down the incident, claiming the damage was limited. However, on Sunday, asserted that the attack should not be downplayed. He said that officials determine how best to demonstrate Iran's power to Israel.

"The evil committed by the Zionist regime (Israel) two nights ago should neither be downplayed nor exaggerated", Iranian media

quoted Khamenei as saying. He also tweeted, "Zionists are making a miscalculation with respect to Iran. They don't know Iran. They still haven't been able to correctly understand the power, initiative, and determination of the Iranian people. We need to make them

understand these things". Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu, meanwhile, said Israel's airstrikes "hit hard" Iran's defences and missile production.

Indian real estate developers secure Rs 12,801 crore

Mumbai : Real estate developers in India raised Rs 12,801 crore via qualified institutional placements (QIPs) in the first nine months this year, which is over 17 per cent of the total QIP issuance across sectors at Rs 75,923 crore, a report showed today.

After renewable energy, real estate came in second highest among sectors to raise funds through QIP so far this year.

"This strong QIP activity highlights the sector's crucial role in India's broader capital markets - and the institutional investors' growing confidence in Indian real estate," said Anuj Puri, Chairman, Anarock Group. According to the report, enhanced transparency, a robust post-pandemic residential real estate recovery, and strong investor confidence are factors driving a surge in activity, thereby positioning the sector for continued growth.

The QIP route allows publiclytraded companies to raise capital by offering equities or securities convertible into equity to preapproved institutional buyers. This fundraising approach lets companies skip the more conventional initial public offering (IPO) route and quickly

Robust housing sales growth after the pandemic has prompted leading developers to unleash inventory across relevant markets.

As per report, over 13.62 lakh units have been launched across the top seven cities between 2021 till this year (January-September).

Concurrently, housing sales in these cities have soared to nearly 14.36 lakh units in this period. Effervescent sales led to an over 10 per cent decline in unsold housing inventory in this period, despite the high rate of supply addition.

To fund their aggressive expansion, these developers are turning to IPOs and the QIP route. Their success in these capitalisation efforts underscore the sector's continued ability to attract both retail and institutional investors. We expect investor participation to grow manifold in the coming years," said Puri.

Simultaneously, the strong postpandemic homebuyers demand has also prompted developers to raise funds via IPOs to fund new project launches across geographies. Since 2021, six developers have collectively raised Rs 5,275 crore through

Tirupati Iskcon temple gets bomb threat

Hyderabad: The Iskcon temple in Andhra Pradesh's Tirupati district received a bomb threat, following which the security of the temple was increased.

According to the police, the staff of the Iskcon temple received an email on October 27, claiming "Pakistan's ISI-related terrorists would blow up the temple".

Upon receiving an alert about the threat email, teams of Bomb Disposal Squad (BDS) and dog squad reached the spot and a search operation was launched at the temple. However, no explosives or any other objectionable items were recovered from the temple premises.

A probe has been launched by the police after the bomb threat to the



Earlier on October 26, two prominent hotels in Tirupati also received bomb threats, which were later confirmed as hoax threats by the police after a thorough search by BDS and sniffer

dogs.
The threat mentioned the alleged drug

trafficking network kingpin Jaffer Sadiq, who was arrested in Tamil Nadu by the Narcotics Control Bureau and the Enforcement Directorate. The mail, which appeared vague, claimed that Tamil Nadu's top cop
"paired with PAK ISI" to carry out blasts to

"divert attention from Kiruthiga Udhayanidhi", wife of Tamil Nadu Deputy Chief Minister Udhayanidhi Stalin.

Prior to this, three other hotels in Tirupati received bomb threats, which were also declared as hoax threats by the security forces following a thorough searches.

No platform tickets' sale in Delhi stations till November 6

New Dehli: There will be no sale of platform tickets at New Delhi, Old Delhi, Hazrat Nizamuddin, Anand Vihar and Delhi Sarai Rohilla railway stations till November 6 in anticipation of a heavy rush of travellers heading to their homes for Diwali and Chhath Puja, Northern Railways has said.

The move comes as 10 people were injured in a stampede at Mumbai's Bandra Terminus railway station on Sunday after hundreds were trying to board a Gorakhpur-bound unreserved train to travel to their native places for the upcoming festival season.

Platform tickets will also not be available at Ghaziabad Junction railway station till November 6. However, persons coming to the stations just to assist the aged, illiterate and women passengers, who are not in a position to fend for themselves, have been exempted from this restriction, Northern Railways said.



Northern Railways has announced the implementation of special crowd management and control measures at New Delhi and Anand Vihar railway stations till November 7 in view of the upcoming festive season.

"In anticipation of high passenger volumes during the upcoming Diwali and Chhath festivals, the Delhi Division of Northern Railway has implemented special crowd management and control measures at New Delhi Railway Station and Anand Vihar till November 7," Northern Railways said in a press release.

A designated holding area has been set up at New Delhi station (Ajmeri Gate side) and Anand Vihar station circulating area, equipped with additional ticket counters, Automatic Ticket Vending Machines, enquiry counters, 'May I Help You' desk, catering services, drinking water and mobile toilets to enhance passenger

The Delhi Rail Division has temporarily closed direct entry from the Delhi metro skywalk to the foot overbridge linking both the stations during the period.

Besides, some trains such as Bihar Sampark Kranti (12566), Sampoorna Kranti (12394), Vaishali Express (12554) and Purshottam Express (12802) have been temporarily reassigned to specific platforms for better crowd control.

Northern Railways urged passengers to arrive at least an hour before their train's scheduled departure to avoid last-minute congestion and ensure a smooth boarding

3 terrorists killed after attack on Army vehicle in J&K's Akhnoor, qunfight on

Jammu: At least three terrorists were killed in a gunfight after they opened fire on an Army vehicle in Jammu and Kashmir's Akhnoor sector today sources said. Security forces also seized arms and ammunition from the area, and the encounter was ongoing.

Official confirmation of the incident is awaited.

At around 7 am in the Batal area, three terrorists opened multiple rounds of fire at the Army vehicle. The security forces promptly cordoned off the area and launched a manhunt, according to sources.

The incident took place as security forces in Jammu and Kashmir had implemented elaborate security measures in the Jammu region in preparation for the Diwali festival



However, in a concerning development, at least 12 people, including two soldiers, have been killed in multiple gunfights across Jammu and Kashmir, especially in the valley, over the past week.

On October 24, terrorists ambushed an Army vehicle near Gulmarg in Baramulla, killing two soldiers and two porters, while earlier that day, a teenager from Uttar Pradesh was injured in a separate attack in Tral, marking the third assault on migrant workers in Kashmir within a week.

> On October 20, terrorists killed seven people, including a doctor and six migrant workers, at a construction site in Sonamarg, Ganderbal district. Another migrant worker from Bihar was attacked two days before this

incident. In vire of these repeated terrorist attacks, a high-level meeting was held at Jammu and Kashmir Lieutenant Governor's house on October 24.

According to an official, an investigation into the attack in Gaderbal district has indicated significant gaps in intelligence and undetected infiltration since last one year along the Line of Control
